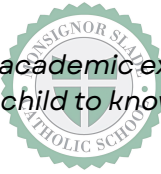

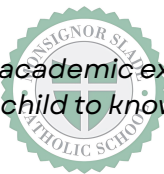
We need to fill the following positions:

NURSE NEWS

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope you and your family had a restful and enjoyable break. As we welcome students back to school, I would like to share a few important health reminders to help keep our school community healthy.

Please remember NOT to send your child to school if they are sick. Students should remain at home if they are experiencing symptoms such as fever 100.0 degrees F or higher, vomiting, diarrhea, persistent cough, sore throat, or any flu-like symptoms. Children should be fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication before returning to school.

Sending a sick child to school increases the risk of spreading illness to classmates & staff and can delay your child's own recovery. If your child becomes ill during the school day, you will be contacted to pick them up as soon as possible.

We also encourage you to remind your children of good hygiene practices, including frequent handwashing, covering coughs and sneezes, and using hand sanitizer when appropriate.

Thank you for your cooperation and partnership in keeping our students & staff healthy and safe. Please feel free to contact the health office if you have any questions or concerns.

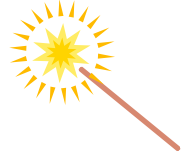

Hi Families,

We're excited to share that preparations for our school musical, *The Wizard of Oz*, are officially underway! As we begin organizing all the moving pieces, we're looking to build an amazing team of parent volunteers to help bring our production to life.

Our goal is to form small groups in the following areas, each with 1-2 parents willing to help lead:

- **Props Team** – Help gather, create, or organize items like baskets, poppies, and other Oz-themed props.
- **Makeup Team** – Assist with simple show-day makeup and guide students during rehearsals.
- **Costume Team** – Support with costume pieces, fittings, organizing, and final show-day prep.
- **Meal & Snack Planning** – Coordinate simple meals or snacks for longer rehearsals and show days.
