MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

<u>Dispense of ALL Medication</u> - If a student's physician recommends that the student receive prescription or over-the-counter medication during the school day, a medication form signed by the student's licensed health care provider is required. Medication, both prescription and non-prescription, can only be dispensed with the below medication form, signed by the health care provider and parent, specifying start and stop dates.

<u>Delivery of Medication to Slade</u> - Medications must be delivered to the school by the parent/guardian in its original box or container. Medications delivered to the school nurse by the student will not be accepted for use, but will be placed in a locked cabinet until the parent/guardian picks up the medication or signs for it.

Students may not possess, dispense, or distribute medication on their own. Under special circumstances, individual students may be authorized by their physician to carry and self-administer emergency medications. In this case, the school nurse must be consulted.



SPECIFIC CONDITION REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for food allergy/bee sting allergy requiring emergency medications:

- Medication Administration Form signed by the licensed health care provider, parent, & school nurse (at drop off).
- Food Allergy Action Plan form signed by the student's licensed health care provider.

Requirements for asthma requiring medications:

- Medication Administration Form signed by the licensed health care provider, parent, & school nurse (at drop off).
- Asthma Action Plan this plan may be substituted for the ordering health care provider's preferred asthma action plan form.

Requirements for prescription medications:

- Medication Administration Form signed by the licensed health care provider, parent, & school nurse (at drop off).
- Medication must be dropped off/refilled in the original bottle provided by the pharmacy.
- Pill count will be performed by the school nurse & the parent/guardian for every controlled substance drop off.

Requirements for over-the-counter medications:

- Medication Administration Form signed by the licensed health care provider, parent, & school nurse (at drop off).
- Medication must be in the original, sealed container.



REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS FOR 2025-2026

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the Maryland Recommended Childhood Immunization.

Kindergarten & Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:

- DTaP/DTP/DT/Td 3 doses
- Polio 3 doses
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- · Varicella 2 doses
- Hepatitis B 3 doses

Grades 7 & 8 Only:

- Tdap 1 dose
- Meningococcal 1 dose

Students without medical or religious exemptions will have **20 calendar days from the start of school** to present documentation of required immunizations OR proof of a scheduled doctor's appointment to receive missing immunizations. If the above documentation is not submitted, students with missing immunizations will be excluded from school until documentation is received.

Each student in Grades 7 & 8 will receive two brown bags on Wednesday, 9/3/2025, to use as they "bag a breakfast." Your breakfast donations should include one of each of the following:

- 1. Small box of cereal or packet of oatmeal w/cup & spoon
- 2. Pop Tart, Nutrigrain Bar, or Granola Bar
- 3. Applesauce cup, fruit cup, or box of raisins
- 4. Hot chocolate pack w/cup & spoon
- 5. Juice Box
- 6. Napkin
