Current COVID-19 Guidelines (as of 1/14/2021)



Terrapin Times:



35th ANNUAL "CHAMPIONS OF COURAGE" ESSAY COMPETITION WINNERS ANNOUNCED

Fifteen (15) Baltimore area students will appear on WBFF-TV FOX 45, WNUV-TV The CW Baltimore and EBFF MyTV Baltimore saluting their personal heroes this January and February. The students are the finalists in the 35th Annual "Champions of Courage" Black History Month Essay Competition.

Essays were received from middle and high schools--public, private, and parochial--throughout the Baltimore metro area. The competition challenged students, grades 6 through 12, to write a brief essay saluting their personal "Champion of Courage"....a positive role model who has touched their lives by sharing the teachings of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

The fifteen (15) finalists will share their salutes to their "Champions of Courage" with FOX 45, The CW Baltimore, and MyTV Baltimore viewers during January and February. Each student essayist will be presented with a \$100. award. The top three essayists will be announced during the broadcast of a Champions of Courage Broadcast Special airing on FOX45, CW Baltimore and myTv Baltimore in February. The top three essayists will be presented with additional awards for their individual effort, and in their honor, their schools will receive cash awards...sharing the lesson that when an individual achieves, his/her community benefits.

"Champions of Courage" is designed to commemorate Black History Month by celebrating positive role models for youth. The essay competition provides opportunity for students to participate in a scholastic competition, to gain confidence in their abilities, and to be recognized for their achievement. "Champions of Courage" also serves to share with one and all the legacy and teachings of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
