#### **Important News & Notes:**

**Snow Days:** The school's calendar had three snow days built in for possible closures. We used our last snow day today, January 7, 2022. Therefore, unless the Archdiocese grants more snow days, MSCS will pivot to virtual online-learning beginning with the next weather closure by AACPS.

**Calendar changes:** Due to changes in COVID protocols and out of an abundance of caution, we have made the following changes to the school calendar:

- The January student snack sale is rescheduled for January 21, 2022.
- January brown bag breakfast donations from Pre-K4 and Kdg are rescheduled for collection on January 21, 2022.
- Class pictures are tentatively rescheduled for January, 26, 2022.
- Activity pictures are tentatively rescheduled for January 27, 2022.
- Aladdin spring musical, originally scheduled for March 11 & 12, will now be held on April 8 & 9, 2022.
- In-person Grandparents days, scheduled for April 11-13, 2022, have been canceled. There will be a virtual performance scheduled for grandparents to log in and enjoy. Date to be determined.

**School Culture Survey:** The Johns Hopkins University Institute for Education Policy is conducting a school culture and climate survey. Students in grades 6-8 will have the opportunity to participate in the student survey, which will be administered on Friday, Janu-



ary 14, 2022. All responses are strictly confidential and will only be analyzed by researchers at JHU. School and Archdiocesan personnel will not have access to individual survey responses.
