Important News and Notes:

We would like to thank all of the parents who attended our HASA General Meeting this past Tuesday, October 8th. Anne Arundel County Police Corporal Jim Shiloh's training on Active Assailants was very informative and well-received. Corporal Shiloh recommended the following resources for parents and children: *The Unthinkable: Who Survives When Disaster Strikes- And Why* by Amanda Ripley; *Mass Shootings: Six Steps to Survival* by John Matthews; *I Am Not Scared....I'm Prepared!* By Julia Cook; and *The Ant Hill Disaster* by Julia Cook. Over the next few weeks, we will determine what developmentally-appropriate conversations we need to have with our students, and then begin practicing those drills so that the students are prepared.
