## Important News & Notes:

- Preschool enrollment projections for next school year indicate a very limited number of openings in Pre-K2, Pre-K3, and Pre-K4 next year. If you wish to submit an application for a student entering any grade at Monsignor Slade in 2023-2024, please do so ASAP. Applications opened for next year on October 3, 2022. While the sibling relationship is considered during application review, we cannot guarantee enrollment for **all** sibling applicants due to the limited number of seats in each class.

### Competitive Basketball Commissioner

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Competitive Basketball Commissioner:

- Administer all aspects of the competitive basketball program to ensure its effective and efficient management while adhering to the Slade Athletic Philosophy and By-laws, Slade Values Code, Archdiocesan policy, County League policy, and school policy.
- Provide for consistency in operation among the individual competitive basketball teams where applicable.
- Meet with county program, schedule teams for games/practices, open registration in Sports Engine site, order uniforms and equipment for program
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings.
- Cast a vote as an active member of the Council.
- Manage all aspects of the competitive basketball program budget, including the submission of annual budgets to the school administration.
- While in season, prepare and submit monthly reports regarding the competitive basketball program to the Athletic Council.
- Work with the Intramural/Clinic Basketball Commissioner on shared resources (scheduling of gym time, basketballs etc.).

### MedKit Coordinator

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the MedKit Coordinator:

- Distribution of medical kits to each sports team in season prior to the start of the first practice.
- Collection of medical kits from each sports team at the end of each season.
- Maintain an inventory of all medical kits in the program and a list of standardized contents and their quantities for each kit and the total program. In the event that a sport should require kit contents more specific or specialized than what is standard issue, the MedKit Coordinator shall provide the items for that particular sport during that season.

## Sports Section (continued):

- Maintain a list of which kits were distributed to which teams.
- Inventory of all returned kits at the end of each sports season.
- Restock of all kit contents back to standard kit quantities.
- Maintain an operating budget for restocking of kit contents and provide a monthly update on the program during the attendance of the Athletic Council meetings.
- Periodic evaluation of the need for additional items that may be sport specific or additions to the standard item list.
- Work with each sport Commissioner to coordinate basic First Aid training for all coaches and assistant coaches on an annual basis prior to the start of each sports season

*(If the program manager is not able to provide the training first-hand, then it will require additional resources from personnel capable of providing the specific training).*

### Treasurer

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Treasurer:

- Attend Athletic Council meetings.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings, including providing relevant information regarding the registration system during the meeting.
- Be responsible for reconciling all monies received through the Slade Sports registration system against statements and any other relevant financial information.
- Coordinate and work with Council Members to ensure the efficient and effective operation of the registration system.
- In coordination with the Council President, handle the Point of Contact (POC) duties for the registration system and ensure all communications are properly routed to the appropriate person(s) for prompt handling and any issues that may arise are properly handled.
- Ensure completeness of and distribute to each Commissioner all information pertinent to any matter regarding the registration system.
- Periodic evaluation of the registration system, in coordination with Council Members, to identify additional requirements for the registration system and present such findings to the Council for review.

### Field Hockey Commissioner

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Field Hockey Commissioner:

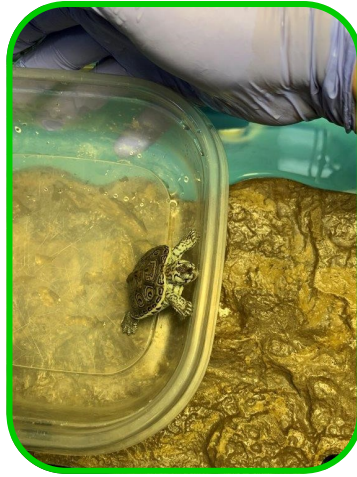
- Administer all aspects of the field hockey program to ensure its effective and efficient management while adhering to the Slade Athletic Policy Guide, Slade Values Code, Archdiocesan policy and school policy.
- Provide consistent operation among individual field hockey teams where applicable.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings.
- Cast a vote as an active member of the council.
- Manage all aspects of the Field Hockey program budget, ordering, uniforms, scheduling.
- While in season, prepare and submit monthly reports regarding Field Hockey to Athletic Council.

## “Spirit of Slade”

### Referral Program

Monsignor Slade Catholic School sponsors a family referral program, “Spirit of Slade,” which rewards the families of currently enrolled full-day Pre-K–7th grade families who refer new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School.



- ◆ Open to all MSCS families with students currently enrolled in full-day Pre-K2 through 7th grade
- ◆ For every new family that lists your family's name in the “Referred by” field on their enrollment application and completes one full year of school at MSCS, your family will receive a **\$500** tuition credit for the following school year.
- ◆ Tuition credits are awarded on a per **FAMILY**, not per student, basis.
- ◆ You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total tuition rate for one student in a family in any given year. Credits will not be applied until a family’s FACTS account is activated for the year in which the credits are to be received. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.

#### To help as you refer new families:

- ◆ A new family is defined as a family NOT currently enrolled in the Edu-Care program/Pre-K2-8th grades at MSCS.
- ◆ Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.

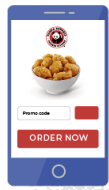
