Parking Lot Safety: For the safety of all:

1. Please become thoroughly familiar with the drop-off and pick-up procedures on pp. 42-45 of our Parent & Student Handbook.
2. Please pull into the lot and park if your child(ren) need assistance opening doors and gathering bags. Do not park and get out of the car in the drop-off lanes. There are several safeties who are stationed around the parking lot to help your children get into the building safely.
3. Please adhere to the one-way traffic sign posted on the roadway outside of the cafeteria. U-turns are not permitted on this roadway.
4. Incoming traffic for afternoon pick-up will be stopped at 2:43 p.m. so that no cars are moving through the parking lot when children are dismissed.
5. Please do not leave running cars unattended in the parking lot.
6. Please remember that Maryland is a hands-free state; therefore, no one should be using a handheld phone while driving on campus.

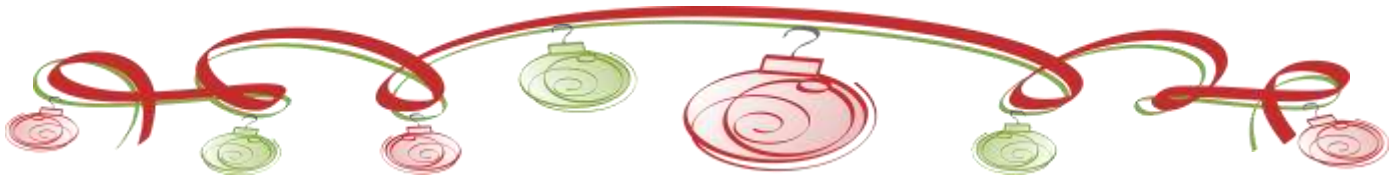

Athletic Council Volunteer Opportunities

Sports Co-Commissioner - Lacrosse

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Co-Commissioner:

- Administer all aspects of the lacrosse program to ensure its effective and efficient management while adhering to the Slade Athletic Policy, Slade Values Code, Archdiocesan policy, and school policy.
- Provide for consistency in operation among the individual lacrosse teams where applicable.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings.
- Cast a vote as an active member of the Council.
- Manage all aspects of the Lacrosse program budget, including the submission of annual budgets to the school administration.
- While in season, prepare and submit monthly reports regarding the lacrosse program to the Athletic Council.
- Work with the current Lacrosse Commissioner on program scheduling and fields

Treasurer

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Treasurer:

- Attend Athletic Council meetings.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings, including providing relevant information regarding the registration system during the meeting.
- Be responsible for reconciling all monies received through the Slade Sports registration system against statements and any other relevant financial information.
- Coordinate and work with Council Members to ensure the efficient and effective operation of the registration system.
- In coordination with the Council President, handle the Point of Contact (POC) duties for the registration system and ensure all communications are properly routed to the appropriate person(s) for prompt handling and any issues that may arise are properly handled.
- Ensure completeness of and distribute to each Commissioner all information pertinent to any matter regarding the registration system.
- Periodic evaluation of the registration system, in coordination with Council Members, to identify additional requirements for the registration system and present such findings to the Council for review.

IT Manager/Webmaster
