Maryland State Police to Participate in National Prescription Drug Take Back Day

October 22, 2018

(PIKESVILLE, Md.) – The Maryland State Police, in partnership with the Drug Enforcement Administration, are asking residents to dispose of any unwanted and expired prescription medications during the latest National Prescription Drug Take Back Day, which will take place from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 27, 2018, at all 23 state police barracks.

Each barrack will act as a collection station to give residents an opportunity to dispose of all unwanted and unused prescription drugs. The National Prescription Drug Take Back Day aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse of medications.

Second only to marijuana, non-medical prescription drugs are the most commonly used drug in the country. According to the Drug Enforcement Administration, a majority of teenagers abusing prescription drugs are finding an unlimited supply in their family's medicine cabinet.

Locally during the last initiative in April 2018, troopers collected nearly 2,155 pounds of prescription drugs. Since 2014, Maryland State Police have collected more than 17,823 pounds of prescription drugs through similar initiatives. For those that cannot make it on Saturday, you can drop them off to any state police barrack at any time of the day throughout the year.

- You cannot "load" your account with money to make purchases in the cafeteria. This is not a debit-style lunch account and any credits issued to your lunch account will automatically apply to your next online purchase;
- The menu offered online each day will be identical to the menu offered in the cafeteria;
- There is a rolling two-day deadline for placing orders for example, if you want to order lunch for Tuesday, November 6th, you will need to place your order before midnight on Sunday, November 4th. Lunch for Wednesday, November 7th would need to be placed before midnight on Monday the 5th, and so on;
- You may place orders for as far in advance as we have menus posted;
- There is a 5% service fee for online ordering to cover the cost of the platform used as well as credit/debit fees.
