Important News & Notes:

Halloween at Slade reminders: Halloween will be celebrated on Monday, October 31st. Students may wear costumes to school; however, costumes must be of simple design, and no large or blow-up costumes are permitted. As is customary, no Hallow-een masks may be worn, and no additional items that are carried as part of the costume may be brought to school. All students should follow the out-of-uniform guidelines as indicated in the Parent & Student Handbook on pg. 46.

The Halloween Parade will be held from 1:30-2:00 p.m. on the parking lot. Parents are welcome to attend. Should it rain, the outdoor parade will be canceled. While an indoor parade will be held, unfortunately, we can not accommodate parents as there is not enough space in the MPR.

Mission Statement



Dear Parents and Students,

I am excited to tell you about a special tradition we have here at Monsignor Slade Catholic School during Christmastime. Once again, we will be able to participate in sending toys to Apopka, Florida, for "The Christmas Store." This service project has been supported enthusiastically by students, parents and teachers alike for close to 40 years! This year, our Apopka Service Project will begin on Tuesday, November 1st, and conclude on Wednesday, November 30th.

Apopka is a migrant farm-worker community located just outside Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The farm-workers of Apopka work hard picking crops but are only paid a minimum wage, and struggle to raise their families and provide for daily needs. In an effort to help the workers, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur developed, "The Christmas Store," a place where donated, new toys are sold for a nominal price. Since the farm-workers are very proud and prefer to buy toys for their children rather than receive charity, they can freely select a gift for their child like we do, and can leave the shop with dignity. All proceeds are turned back to the community to fund educational programs, such as literacy and pesticide training.

If you would like to participate, purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good arts & crafts kits, "pretend" jewelry and make-up kits, educational games and books, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, tricycles, helmets, dolls of all colors, cars and trucks (especially medium/large vehicles), board games, and sports balls of all kinds. They can also use diapers, toys, clothing and blankets for infants and toddlers as well as new socks, pajamas and underwear for boys and girls. Allowing your child to help select the toy, and if possible, pay for part of it, will make the project more meaningful to your child.

We are very fortunate to have a great relationship with Southwest Airlines, who has generously agreed each year to provide air transport to Florida. Our student council members will pack up the toys on Thursday, December 1st, and Southwest will come to pick up and then transport the toys to Apopka, Florida, on Friday, December 2nd.

Our efforts in Apopka are greatly appreciated and are truly making a difference in the community. Thank you for your help and support!

ATHLETIC COUNCIL OPENINGS FOR 2023-2024

Competitive Basketball Commissioner

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Competitive Basketball Commissioner:

- Administer all aspects of the Competitive basketball program to ensure its effective and efficient management while adhering to the Slade Athletic Philosophy and By-laws, Slade Values Code, Archdiocesan policy, County League policy and school policy.
- Provide for consistency in operation among the individual competitive basketball teams where applicable.
- Meet with the county program, schedule teams for games/ practices, open registration in the Sports Engine site, order uniforms and equipment for the program.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings.
- Cast a vote as an active member of the Council.
- Manage all aspects of the Competitive Basketball program budget, including the submission of annual budgets to the school administration.
- While in season, prepare and submit monthly reports regarding the Competitive Basketball program to the Athletic Council.
- Work with the Intramural/Clinic Basketball Commissioner on shared resources (scheduling of gym time, basketballs etc.).

MedKit Coordinator

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the MedKit Coordinator:

- Distribution of medical kits to each sports team in season prior to the start of the first practice.
- Collection of medical kits from each sports team at the end of each season.
- Maintain an inventory of all medical kits in the program and a list of standardized contents and their quantities for each kit and the total program. In the event that a sport should require kit contents more specific or specialized than what is standard issue, the MedKit Coordinator shall provide the items for that particular sport during that season.
- Maintain a list of which kits were distributed to which teams.
- Inventory of all returned kits at the end of each sports season.
- Restock of all kit contents back to standard kit quantities.
- Maintain an operating budget for restocking of kit contents and provide a monthly update on the program during the attendance of the Athletic Council meetings.
- Periodic evaluation of the need for additional items that may be sport specific or additions to the standard item list.
- Work with each sport Commissioner to coordinate basic First Aid training for all coaches and assistant coaches on an annual basis prior to the start of each sports season. (If the program manager is not able to provide the training first hand then it will require additional resources from personnel capable of providing the specific training).

Treasurer

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Treasurer:

- Attend Athletic Council meetings.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings, including providing relevant information regarding the registration system during the meeting.
- Be responsible for reconciling all monies received through the Slade Sports registration system against statements and any other relevant financial information.

- Coordinate and work with Council Members to ensure the efficient and effective operation of the registration system.
- In coordination with the Council President, handle the Point of Contact (POC) duties for the registration system and ensure all communications are properly routed to the appropriate person(s) for prompt handling and any issues that may arise are properly handled.
- Ensure completeness of and distribute to each Commissioner all information pertinent to any matter regarding the registration system.
- Periodic evaluation of the registration system, in coordination with Council Members, to identify
 additional requirements for the registration system and present such findings to the Council for
 review.

Field Hockey Commissioner

Earns all 12 required service hours each year.

The Duties of the Field Hockey Commissioner:

- Administer all aspects of the field hockey program to ensure its effective and efficient management while adhering to the Slade Athletic Policy Guide, Slade Values Code, Archdiocesan policy and school policy.
- Provide consistent operation among individual field hockey teams where applicable.
- Participate in Athletic Council meetings.
- Cast a vote as an active member of the council.
- Manage all aspects of the Field Hockey program budget, ordering, uniforms, scheduling.
- While in season, prepare and submit monthly reports regarding Field Hockey to the Athletic Council.
