Important News & Notes:

Family Income Survey: Final Reminder—Each year, the Maryland State Department of Education tasks the Archdiocese of Baltimore schools with collecting family income data. Historically, families have received a paper form that is filled out and returned to school. This year, the information will be collected through a secure Google form: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/

e/1FAIpQLSfgzg7It0zs4nQXaAiWsZf9fMw0wOlm8d4ISVkHZrW0CQ2_yQ/viewform. The information gathered through this survey is completely confidential and will assist Monsignor Slade Catholic School in receiving state textbook funding and grants. Families are asked to **complete one survey per student** enrolled in Pre-K-8th grades at Monsignor Slade. The survey takes approximately 2-4 minutes to complete, and it **must be submitted by October 15, 2020**. We appreciate your prompt attention to this very important matter.

Fall Parent Conferences: Parent conference letters were sent to all families on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, with information about your appointment date and time. Just a reminder that conferences are mandatory for parents of students in Pre-K4 through 2nd grade and all new families in grades 3-8. If your child is in grades Pre-K4 - 2, or a new student to Slade, you should have either received a printed letter (if your child is an in-person student) or an email (if your child is a remotelearner). Teachers may have also requested a conference for your returning student in grade 3-8. Please respond to Mrs. Kathie Sullivan, Support Programs Coordinator, to confirm your appointment date and time. Her email address is k.sullivan@msladeschool.com.

In addition, please be reminded that, if you did not receive a request for a conference concerning your returning student in grade 3-8, it simply means that the teacher(s) did not feel it was necessary to conference at this time; however, if you have some concerns you would like to discuss with your child's teacher(s), you may request a conference by emailing Mrs. Sullivan at k.sullivan@msladeschool.com. The dates for parents to request a conference are Friday, October 9, through Monday, October 12th, by 3:00 p.m.

Mode-of-Learning Commitment: As a reminder, sometime during the first week of November, we will be sending out a new intent form to parents so that you can indicate whether your child will be an in-person or remote student during the second trimester, which begins November 30, 2020. All families will need to complete the intent form, whether or not your mode of learning is changing, so that we may adequately prepare classrooms to accommodate social distancing.

Temporary Remote Learning Reminder: All books and materials will be sent home for students who are designated as temporary remote learners and are required to be out several days to two weeks due to the need to quarantine until a COVID test result or alternate diagnosis is received. If a student is going to be absent for just a day or two, we ask that students and parents not request that all materials be sent

home. Students, if well enough, are still welcomed to join classes remotely. Should parents desire that their student bring home all materials nightly, students are welcomed to do that; however, Chromebooks will not be sent home on a nightly basis. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in this matter.

Grade Level Reminders:

Grade 8: The HSPT Registration Portal is now open. Click on the link to register your students for the December 2, 2020, test which will be held here at MSCS. The cost of the test is \$40 and must be paid online when you register. Nut Allergy Reminder:

• Please avoid packing food products that contain nuts in your child's lunch. I understand that in previous years there was a nut-free table in the cafeteria to limit exposure for students with allergies, and lunches containing nuts were allowed at the other tables. However, due to COVID-19 related changes and the changing of seasons, students will be eating in classrooms consistently in the upcoming months. According to page 23 of the Parent and Student Handbook, "All K-8 classrooms in Monsignor Slade Catholic School are peanut/tree nut free. Please do not send in any peanuts, peanut butter or food containing nuts or nut products to be eaten in the classroom." We must be vigilant when it comes to allergies and protecting those who have severe reactions to nuts.

Travel Tips:

• If you travel to an area that has a greater than 10% positivity rate, a negative COVID-19 PCR test is required in order to be able to return to school. Please email absences@msladeschool.com for travel-related absences.

Fall Conference Procedures

Please be reminded: Conferences for students in Pre-K4 through 2nd grade and conferences for all <u>new</u> students in grades 3-8 are mandatory. Conferences for <u>returning</u> students in grades 3-8 may be requested by either the teacher or the parent. This year, all conferences will be held virtually due to COVID-19. After all conference appointments have been confirmed, your child's teacher will contact you individually with log-on information for your scheduled conference.

- 1. All teacher-requested and mandatory conference dates and times will be sent home in a printed letter for in-person learners or by email for remote learners on Tuesday, October 6, 2020.
- 2. Please confirm/accept your scheduled conference time by email to Mrs. Kathie Sullivan, Support Programs Coordinator, at k.sullivan@msladeschool.com by Friday, October 9, 2020.
- 3. Parent requests for conferences will be accepted on Friday, October 9, and Monday, October 12, 2020, for students in grades 3 through 8. These requests are to be emailed to Mrs. Sullivan at k.sullivan@msladeschool.com no later than 3:00 p.m., on Monday, October 12th. Please be sure to state your child's full name and grade in the request.

Parents who have requested conferences will receive an emailed confirmation of their scheduled date and time by Tuesday, October 13, 2020.

Scholarship Program

The Maryland State Council of the Knights of Columbus in partnership with the Knights of Columbus Insurance Advisors is the sponsor of several High School Scholarships for its members and for Catholic students in general. Below is a summary of these scholarships and information regarding eligibility for scholarship awards.

The Frederick M. Gossman Memorial High School Scholarship

Designed to assist those Brother Knights, in good standing and holding membership in councils within the jurisdiction of Maryland in paying tuition for their sons and daughters at accredited Catholic High Schools; three grants of \$1,500.00 per year, for up to four years, will be awarded. Awards will be made based on academic excellence, personal qualifications, and financial need. The children of deceased members are also eligible, provided the member was in good standing at the time of death.

The William J. O'Brien Jr., Memorial Catholic High School Scholarship

Three grants of \$1,500.00 per year for up to four years will be awarded. This program is open to any <u>Catholic student</u> who is a resident of the State of Maryland, including children and grandchildren of any member, in good standing, of a Knights of Columbus council within the jurisdiction of Maryland. Applicants must have been officially accepted at or must be students at accredited Catholic High Schools. Applications will be judged on academic excellence, personal qualifications, and <u>financial need</u>.

Application period is from October 1, 2020 to February 1, 2021. All applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than February 1, 2021.

Congestion or runny nose

Stay home if symptoms begin before school, or go to the school nurse if symptoms start during the school day.



When can I return to school?

Positive COVID-19 PCR Test

May return 10 days after symptoms first appeared


AND

At least 24 hours no fever without taking medication

AND

Symptoms have improved.

Close contacts should stay home for 14 days from date of last exposure to <u>confirmed or</u> <u>suspected</u> (no alternative diagnosis) case.



No COVID-19 PCR Test Done

May return 10 days after symptoms first appeared

AND

At least 24 hours no fever without taking medication

AND

Symptoms have improved.

OR


Doctor's note with a <u>written alternative</u> <u>diagnosis</u> and symptoms have improved/no fever for 24 hours without medication.

Negative COVID-19 PCR Test

At least 24 hours no fever without taking medicine

AND

Respiratory symptoms have improved.




