Dear Parents and Students,

I am excited to tell you about a special tradition we have here at Monsignor Slade Catholic School during Christmastime. For over 30 years, MSCS has sent toys to Apopka, Florida, for "The Christmas Store." This service project has been supported enthusiastically by students, parents and teachers alike. This year, our Apopka Service Project will begin on Monday, November 5th and conclude on Friday, November 30th .

Apopka is a migrant farm-worker community located just outside Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The farm-workers of Apopka work hard picking crops but are only paid a minimum wage, and struggle to raise their families and provide for daily needs. In an effort to help the workers, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur developed, "The Christmas Store," a place where donated, new toys are sold for a nominal price. Since the farm-workers are very proud and prefer to buy toys for their children rather than receive charity, they can freely select a gift for their child like we do, and can leave the shop with dignity. All proceeds are turned back to the community to fund educational programs, such as literacy and pesticide training.

If you would like to participate, purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good arts & crafts kits, colorful reading books, scooters, ethnic dolls, cars and trucks of all kinds, and sports balls of all kinds. They can also use diapers and blankets for babies and toddlers. Allowing your child to help select the toy, and if possible, pay for part of it, will make the project more meaningful to your child.

We are very fortunate to have a great relationship with Southwest Airlines, who has generously agreed each year to provide air transport to Florida. We are looking for donations of plain, brown boxes for shipping (size 18x18x24). If you have access to large, sturdy packing boxes, please call Lisa Palazzo at 410-766-7130.

Our efforts in Apopka are greatly appreciated and are truly making a difference in the community. Thank you for your help and support!

VETERAN'S DAY SERVICE PROJECT

Monsignor Slade Catholic School will participate in a Veteran's Day service project – "Stockings for Soldiers." We will fill Christmas stockings that will be sent to soldiers serving our country. We are asking each student to bring in 2 – 3 of the following items by **Monday, November 12, 2018:**

- Small candy mini candy bars, hard candy, chewing gum
- Granola / fruit / breakfast / protein bars
- Cookies, nuts, pretzels, trail mix (less than 12 oz. size)
- Flavored drink mixes (please keep in mind that the container needs to fit inside a Santa Stocking) – hot chocolate, lemonade, teas, coffee, energy
- Slim Jims / beef jerky
- Small individual meals Ramen noodle soup, Cup of Noodles, tuna, mac 'n' cheese (8 oz. or less)
- Current DVD movies, CDs, paperback books (no romance)
- Pocket games, puzzles, Sudoku, crosswords, playing cards
- Chapstick, lip balm
- Travel size toothpaste, toothbrushes, toiletries, baby wipes, foot powder, razors, sunblock lotion
- Hand / foot warmers
- Dog / canine items for deployed K9 soldiers
- * Toiletries must be travel size
- * NO aerosol cans (shaving cream, mousse, foot spray, sunblock), bars of soap, nail polish or nail polish remover
- * All items must be new, unused, and sealed.

The stockings will be sent to our soldiers through the kindness of Kirkley-Ruddick Funeral Home. We thank you for helping our school show our support for all the brave men and women serving our country.



Grant & Aid Assessment

FACTS Management makes quality education affordable for families by assisting schools in awarding financial aid. We work with schools to create a custom application and collect financial data so schools can make accurate award decisions based on financial need.

After completing the online application, you will need to upload or fax all required supporting documentation. Uploaded documents must be in PDF format and the size of each document must be less than 20 MB. If you are unable to upload, fax the required documents to 866.315.9264. Please **DO NOT** use your mobile device to photo copy required documents due to problems with legibility.

The following supporting documents are required to complete the application process:

- IRS Federal Income Tax Return, including all supporting schedules (the year of the tax return depends on the tax requirements of your school). If applicant and co-applicant file separately, we require both tax returns for the same tax year.
- Copies of <u>all</u> the current year W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both the applicant and co-applicant.
 NOTE: If you are applying before you have received all the current year W-2 Wage and Tax Statements, please submit them as soon as they become available.
- Copies of all supporting tax documents if you have business income/loss from any of the following:
 Business send Schedule(s) and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 Farm send Schedule(s) and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 Rental Property send Schedule(s)
 S-Corporation send Schedule(s), Form 1120S (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 Partnership send Schedule(s), Form 1065 (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 Estates and Trusts send Schedule(s), Form 1041 and Schedule K-1

*IMPORTANT: If you file a tax return but do not have W-2 wages because you are self-employed, you will be required to submit a copy of your current year Federal Form 1040 Tax Return.

Copies of all supporting documentation for <u>household Non-Taxable Income</u> such as:
 Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and Temporary
 Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). If you do not file a tax return, you are <u>required</u> to provide
 documentation of all income received.

*All documentation received is imaged upon receipt and then destroyed.

You may login to your FACTS user account to review the status of your application. Please allow 2 weeks processing time from the date you provided the supporting documents before inquiring further about receipt and/or status of the uploaded or faxed documents. Application deadlines are set by the institution awarding the scholarships. If you are applying after the deadline, please contact your school to ensure that your application will be accepted.

*A non-refundable application fee may be required before your application will be submitted.

NOTE: Award decisions are made by the institution providing the scholarship, not FACTS.




