Dear Parents and Students,

I am excited to tell you about a special tradition we have here at Monsignor Slade Catholic School during Christmastime. Once again, we will be able to participate in sending toys to Apopka, Florida, for "The Christmas Store." This service project has been supported enthusiastically by students, parents and teachers alike for close to 40 years! This year, our Apopka Service Project will begin on Tuesday, November 1st, and conclude on Wednesday, November 30th.

Apopka is a migrant farm-worker community located just outside Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The farm-workers of Apopka work hard picking crops but are only paid a minimum wage, and struggle to raise their families and provide for daily needs. In an effort to help the workers, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur developed, "The Christmas Store," a place where donated, new toys are sold for a nominal price. Since the farm-workers are very proud and prefer to buy toys for their children rather than receive charity, they can freely select a gift for their child like we do, and can leave the shop with dignity. All proceeds are turned back to the community to fund educational programs, such as literacy and pesticide training.

If you would like to participate, purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good arts & crafts kits, "pretend" jewelry and make-up kits, educational games and books, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, tricycles, helmets, dolls of all colors, cars and trucks (especially medium/large vehicles), board games, and sports balls of all kinds. They can also use diapers, toys, clothing and blankets for infants and toddlers as well as new socks, pajamas and underwear for boys and girls. Allowing your child to help select the toy, and if possible, pay for part of it, will make the project more meaningful to your child.

We are very fortunate to have a great relationship with Southwest Airlines, who has generously agreed each year to provide air transport to Florida. Our student council members will pack up the toys on Thursday, December 1st, and Southwest will come to pick up and then transport the toys to Apopka, Florida, on Friday, December 2nd.

Our efforts in Apopka are greatly appreciated and are truly making a difference in the community. Thank you for your help and support!



Join the BRAINY research study Help us learn more about recovery from concussion!

Seeking children 10-17 years old who recently had a concussion, and children 11-17 years old who have NEVER had a concussion, for a research study online or in-person

We are recruiting children with a concussion and children who have **never** had a concussion, as uninjured comparisons, to participate in a research study to learn about recovery from a concussion.

WHAT: <u>Online:</u> Child will complete thinking tests and a motor task. Parent will complete questionnaires sent via email link. Online visits last 1-2 hours.

In-person: Child will complete thinking and motor tasks and will have Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI – no radiation) scans. Parent will complete questionnaires via iPad. In-person visits last 3-5 hours.

For concussed participants, the first visit will occur soon after the child has recovered from concussion. For all participants, the second and third visits will be 3 and 12 months after the first visit and each visit can be online or in-person. Monthly surveys will be completed between visits.

WHERE: **Online:** Zoom.

In-person: Kennedy Krieger Institute, Baltimore, MD.

BENEFIT: There are no significant risks or direct medical benefits for participating in this study.
