Dear Monsignor Slade Families,

Whether this is your first year as part of the Slade community or you are a longtime family, we value your commitment to our students and our school. As we begin planning for the coming school year, please review the following information and timeline regarding re-registration for the 2023-2024 academic year.

**November 28, 2022:** On CyberMonday, we will have a **one-day only**, per-student offer of 50% off the re-registration fee. Families will be able to re-register at the discounted rate of \$75 per student from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on November 28<sup>th</sup> only. On the day prior to the event, parents will be reminded via email and provided the link necessary to access your parent portal and re-register. However, due to waitlists already formed, please note students who are currently enrolled in Pre-K2 or Pre-K3 *must* re-register on November 28, 2022, in order to ensure their Pre-K3 or Pre-K4 seat for the 2023-2024 academic year.

**January 3 - January 28, 2023**: Re-register Monsignor Slade students at the regular rate of \$150 per student. New tuition rates for the coming school year will be announced during this time. All families must re-register their current student(s) by 11:59 p.m. on January 29, 2023. In addition, families who wish to enroll siblings of current students in Pre-K2 through 8<sup>th</sup> grade must do so prior to the end of the re-registration window.

### We cannot guarantee sibling priority of admissions in grades Kindergarten-8th for any application received after January 28, 2023.

Re-registration for current students will be accepted after January 28, 2023, provided there are seats available in the anticipated grade. If a student is re-registered on or after January 29, 2023, a per-student late fee of \$100 will be assessed making the cost of re-registration a total of \$250.00 per student.
