- Exciting Change to volunteer compliance management system (Shield the Vulnerable) We are happy to announce that as of November 1, 2017, the Archdiocese of Baltimore joined over ninety other dioceses in using VIRTUS as a training and compliance management system. VIRTUS is integrated with Employment Screening Resources (ESR), which means that the criminal history screening process used by our school since 2014 will remain unchanged. VIRTUS has worked with us to customize training tailored to our policies to Maryland law.

We anticipate the conversion from STV to VIRTUS to be seamless. Current volunteers compliant through Shield the Vulnerable will not be impacted by the change and will not be required to do anything until due for renewal. Instructions and a link to VIRTUS are available on our website.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In 2014 the Archdiocese of Baltimore contracted with *Shield the Vulnerable* to provide online child protection training based on the Archdiocese of Baltimore's *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel* and *A Statement of Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth*. For the first time, people serving in our parishes and schools were able to complete online all of the requirements for volunteer service. Late in September, *Shield the Vulnerable* announced that its platform will not be available after October 31, 2017. We had no control over this decision or the timing of the changes it requires.

We are glad to announce that as of November 1, 2017, the Archdiocese of Baltimore will join more than ninety dioceses using VIRTUS as a training and compliance management system. VIRTUS has worked with us to customize training tailored to our policies and to Maryland law.

The Archdiocesan policies updated in 2014 remain unchanged. Thanks to the transfer of data from *Shield the Vulnerable*, most volunteers and employees will not be required to access the system at this time. Church personnel, including volunteers, who have not already registered in *Shield the Vulnerable*, will be required to register using VIRTUS. VIRTUS will direct volunteers to review the *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel* and *A Statement of Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth*. The Archdiocese of Baltimore will continue to work with Employment Screening Resources (ESR) to conduct online criminal history screening; as part of the registration process, VIRTUS will direct volunteers to the ESR website where they will be asked to submit to an online criminal history screening. VIRTUS can be accessed at: <a href="https://www.virtusonline.org">https://www.virtusonline.org</a>.

Dear Parents and Students,

I am excited to tell you about a special tradition we have here at Monsignor Slade Catholic School during Christmastime. For over 30 years, MSCS has sent toys to Apopka, Florida, for "The Christmas Store." This service project has been supported enthusiastically by students, parents and teachers alike. This year, our Apopka Service Project will begin on Monday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, and conclude on Friday, December 1st.

Apopka is a migrant farm-worker community located just outside Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The farm-workers of Apopka work hard picking crops but are only paid a minimum wage, and struggle to raise their families and provide for daily needs. In an effort to help the workers, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur developed, "The Christmas Store," a place where donated, new toys are sold for a nominal price. Since the farm-workers are very proud and prefer to buy toys for their children rather than receive charity, they can freely select a gift for their child like we do, and can leave the shop with dignity. All proceeds are turned back to the community to fund educational programs, such as literacy and pesticide training.

If you would like to participate, purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good arts & crafts kits, colorful reading books, scooters, ethnic dolls, cars and trucks of all kinds, and sports balls of all kinds. They can also use diapers and blankets for babies and toddlers. Allowing your child to help select the toy, and if possible, pay for part of it, will make the project more meaningful to your child.

We are very fortunate to have a great relationship with Southwest Airlines, who has generously agreed each year to provide air transport to Florida. We are looking for donations of plain, brown boxes for shipping (size 18x18x24). If you have access to large, sturdy packing boxes, please call Lisa Palazzo at 410-766-7130.

Our efforts in Apopka are greatly appreciated and are truly making a difference in the community. Thank you for your help and support!



### Referral Program

Monsignor Slade Catholic School is excited to announce a Family Referral Program, "Spirit of Slade," that will apply toward the 2018-2019 school year. Please consider sharing the opportunity to be enriched by the "Spirit of Slade" and this community with other families. Our parents and current students are our greatest ambassadors; we count on you to help our school grow and succeed. This program will reward both currently enrolled full-time Pre-K4 - 7th grade families who have referred new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School and the new family who enrolls.

### **Current Families**

- ♦ Open to all MSCS families with currently enrolled Pre-K4 (full-time) through 7th grade students
- For every new family that lists your family's name in the "Referred by" field on their enrollment applicant form and completes one full year of school with us, your family will receive a \$250 tuition credit for the following school year.
- Tuition credits are awarded on a per *FAMILY*, not per student, basis.
- You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total Catholic rate tuition for any given year. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.

### For example:

- ⇒ You recommend Family A for next year. Family A registers, lists your family in the "Referred by" field on the application form, and successfully completes the 2017-2018 school year at Slade. Your family will then receive \$250 credit toward the 2018-2019 school year in FACTS.
- ⇒ Your family was also listed on Family B's application and they successfully completed the 2017-18 school year. Your family will receive another \$250 credit toward the 2018-2019 school year.
- ⇒ This can be repeated additional times for the same school year until the credit to your account equals one full 2018-2019 tuition rate (registered Catholic amount). \*For referring family only.

### **Prospective New Families**

- ♦ A new family is defined as a family NOT currently enrolled in either the Pre-K program on the Pre-K4- 8th grade at MSCS.
- Prospective families receive a \$250 tuition credit by listing the fully enrolled Pre-K4 (full-time) 7th grade Referring Family's name on their initial enrollment application. Tuition credits are awarded on a per *FAMILY*, not per student, basis. Tuition credits *are not* transferrable.
- Only one family may be listed as a Referring Family. There are no exceptions to this.
- New family must be registered by October 31, 2017, and complete the entire 2017-2018 school year and be current on all accounts in order to earn \$250 credit toward 2018-2019 tuition.
