Early Dismissal Policy: All early dismissal requests must be made in writing by the parent/guardian, either by a handwritten note delivered in the morning to the homeroom teacher in the child's take-home folder, or emailed from the parent/guardian's email addressed to the child's homeroom teacher and absences@msladeschool.com. The teacher will notify the receptionist of where the student will be at the time of pickup.

Included in this request for early dismissal should be the time of dismissal and the person's name that is picking up. The person responsible for pickup will need to show a driver's license to the front office and sign the early dismissal log. After this process is completed, the child will be called from the classroom.

For your convenience, we have sent home an excuse pad today with your oldest/only student. These notepads are designed to aid in writing a quick note to your child's teacher. They can be used for early dismissal, as well as late arrival, notes about homework, etc. We hope that they will prove to be useful for your family.

Calendar Changes: The Archdiocese has granted all schools the ability to convert three full days to half days in order to provide more professional and wellness development time for teachers and staff. Parents, please note the following changes to our academic calendar:

- Tuesday, December 21st 12:15 dismissal. PreK-2 and PreK-3 classes will also • dismiss at 12:15 p.m. Extended Care is closed.
- Friday, February 4th 12:15 dismissal for grades PreK-4-8th grades only.
- Thursday, April 14th -12:15 dismissal. PreK-2 and PreK-3 classes will also dismiss at 12:15 p.m. Extended Care is closed.

NEW COVID-19 GUIDELINES AS OF NOVEMBER 22, 2021:

- New modified quarantine option for unvaccinated students who are exposed to a positive classmate while both students are properly and consistently masked.
 - Test-to-stay option:
 - If asymptomatic, close contacts may continue to remain in school as long as they are tested on days 1, 3, 5, and 7 following exposure. The exposed student(s) should continue to wear a mask in school settings and monitor for symptoms for 14 days.
 - Testing will be performed at school using the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag CARD.
 - Consent is required for all testing at school.
 - If the close contact student becomes symptomatic, they will need to remain home and receive a COVID-19 PCR test.
 - This option does not apply to unmasked contacts, or contact with positive adults, family members, or other children outside of the school building.
 - Other options for unvaccinated students:
 - Test on day 5, return day 8:
 - If asymptomatic, students are able to receive a PCR test on day 5 after exposure and return to school on day 8.
 - Monitor for symptoms for a full 14 days after exposure.
 - Quarantine for 10 days, no testing required if asymptomatic.
 - Monitor for symptoms for a full 14 days after exposure.
- If the student is fully vaccinated (2 weeks after the second dose in their COVID-19 vaccination series), they must receive a COVID-19 PCR test between day 5-7 but may remain in school if asymptomatic.
- The 10-day isolation period for individuals positive with COVID-19 has not changed.

TRAVEL GUIDANCE:

- Domestic Travel:
 - Currently there are no specific restrictions, testing or quarantine requirements relative to domestic travel being required by the CDC or the State of Maryland.
 - Domestic travel includes travel to any destination within the United States, including Alaska and Hawaii, and all U.S. possessions and territories.
- International Travel:
 - For those planning international travel, you are referred to the guidance offered by the CDC regarding preparations for and returning from international travel. From the School Nurse (continued):

- Specifically with regard to returning from international travel, you are referred to the section on the above referenced webpage entitled "After Arrival in the United States". Those returning from international travel are expected to comply with the following guidance issued by the CDC:
 - ALL International Travelers
 - Get tested with a COVID-19 viral test 3-5 days after travel.
 - Self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms; isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms.
 - Follow all state and local recommendations or requirements after travel.
 - If the traveler is not fully vaccinated, in addition to the testing guidance above the individual must comply with the following requirements:
 - Stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if you test negative at 3-5 days.
 - If you don't get tested, stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
- As a reminder, the above protocols are subject to change if there are changes with regard to the spread of virus. If changes are required, families will be updated. However, families must comply with the guidance in force at the time of travel.


