


NOTES FROM THE HEALTH ROOM

Is it a Cold or the Flu?

It is official! Flu season is in full swing with widespread flu activity. In order to help keep everyone healthy, it is important to practice good hygiene and hand washing. Please remind yourself and your family to:

- Cover mouth with your bent elbow when coughing or sneezing.
- Wash hands frequently with soap for 20 seconds.
- Don't share food or drink.
- Secondhand smoke increases the rate of respiratory illness in children.
- Encourage plenty of sleep, fluids and a balanced diet.
- Get your flu shot.



Symptoms	Cold	Flu
Fever	Rarely (Low grade)	Usually
Headache	Occasionally	Prominent
General aches and pains	Slight	Usual: often quite severe
Fatigue and weakness	Mild	Extreme: can last 2-3 weeks
Prostration (extreme exhaustion)	Never	Early and prominent
Runny, stuffy nose	Common	Sometimes
Sneezing	Usual	Sometimes
Sore throat	Common	Sometimes
Chest discomfort, cough	Mild to moderate; hacking cough	Common: can be severe

Children must be completely free of fever for 24 hours before returning to school without the use of fever reducing medications (ex. Tylenol or Motrin)

2018 Flu Season Parent Information:

The CDC advises that children with asthma, diabetes, or any other medical condition that could impact their ability to fight the flu should consult a physician if flu symptoms develop. Children under two are also a higher risk and should be seen.

For other children, who usually recover from illness without problems, if any of the follow symptoms present, they should be seen immediately by their pediatrician or urgent care:

- Fast breathing or trouble breathing
- Bluish or gray skin color
- Not drinking enough fluids (not going to the bathroom/making as much urine as normal)
- Severe or persistent vomiting
- Not waking up or not interacting
- Being so irritable that the child does not want to be held
- Flu symptoms improve, but then return with fever and worse cough

PLEASE NOTE:

- If your child has borrowed a uniform from the health room, please wash and return it.
- The health room could use facial tissues and size 6 girl's underwear.


