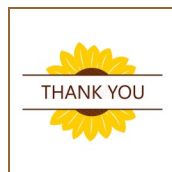

Monsignor Slade Performing Arts Trip to NYC



Who: Any middle school student who has participated in any of our performing arts programs at Slade and their VIRTUS-compliant guardians.

When: Wednesday, April 19, 2023, leaving Slade at 6:00 a.m. and returning to Slade at 10:00 p.m.

Where: We will spend the day in Times Square with your chaperone group - eat lunch, shop, sight-see, then meet at the Gershwin Theater to see Wicked at 2:00 p.m. We have orchestra seating. We will leave NYC after the show and do a fast food stop on the way home for dinner.

How: We will travel by coach bus provided by Hubers Bus Company.

There will be a time-stamped Google Form released on Saturday, March 4, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. -11:00 a.m. Ticket orders will be taken on a first-come, first-go basis with 8th grade students and parents receiving priority until 10:30 a.m. We will send out a reservation list by email of the approved ticket recipients. Please remember that all chaperones must be VIRTUS-compliant. There will be a 3:1 ratio for chaperones vs students, so we will accept the first 10 adults who will chaperone 39 students.

Cost: The cost of the trip is \$165 each, which covers the theater ticket and your bus seat. You will also need money for lunch and dinner.
