T3 Returning Students: March 5, 2021, marks the start of T3. Many students will be returning to in-person learning for the first time this year on this date. Parents, you will begin receiving a wellness survey each morning for your child (ren). Please be sure to fill it out prior to arriving on campus. When you arrive, please have a large sign with the last name and grade level(s) of the child(ren) who are being dropped off. After being directed to a drop-off lane, all students should wait in their cars until a staff member signals that it is fine to step out; students should exit to the right of the vehicle. They will then follow the yellow line down to a yellow cone where students will wait until a staff member directs them to walk to the building. All Pre-K4-1st grade students enter through the carport door. All 3rd, 7th, and 8th students enter through the middle stairwell doors. Signs are posted in the morning to help direct students to their correct entrances. We look forward to welcoming back more students for this final trimester of the 2020-2021 school year.


Parish News:

Monsignor Slade Catholic School is partnering once again with a Peruvian school named Lord of Polallucay, which is the only Catholic school in Yungay, Peru. During Lent, we would like to continue our mission work with our sister school and collect food items to benefit those in need.

DURING THIS LENT, PLEASE KEEP IN MIND PEOPLE IN NEED.

We will collect 6 staple food items:

PASTA	Pre-K2, Pre-K3, Pre-K4 & Kdg.
SUGAR	Grades 1 & 2
FLOUR	Grades 3 & 4
RICE	Grades 5 & 6
CANNED VEGGIES	Grades 7 & 8
COOKING OIL	Grades 7 & 8

The food collected will be used at the mission school, local soup kitchens and hospitals, as well as others in need in the town of Yungay, Peru.

Operation Mato Grosso's objective is to fill an entire shipping container of food to send to Peru sometime after Easter.

Ed Thomas is the Aglow International, Mid-Atlantic Region's Anti-Human Trafficking Coordinator. Ed is also a Co-Chairman of the Eastern Shore (Maryland) Human Trafficking Task Force and participates in the work of the Maryland Human Trafficking Task Force. Ed and his wife Anne are long- time residents of Pasadena, Maryland.

"The public is unaware that human trafficking, sex and labor exploitation, occurs in their communities and that there are steps they can take to prevent and stop trafficking. Young people, social media, and human trafficking, unfortunately, go together." —Ed Thomas
