Important News & Notes:

Health & Safety Information: Since your children's health and safety is our primary concern, we want you to know that we are monitoring communications and directives regarding the coronavirus outbreak very closely. In addition, we want to make you aware that our school cleaning staff disinfects all common areas of the school on a regular basis, including door knobs, bannisters, bathrooms, cafeteria, stairwells, etc. The teachers have been instructed to disinfect desks and chairs, as well as other items in the classrooms, on a daily basis. We will send out any further notices and/or information from the Archdiocese and/or local agencies as they become available. Please see "Notes from the Health Room" below for additional information.

Notes from the Health Room:

Flu season is still upon us with widespread activity reported in Maryland and most of the country. Prevention of the flu as well as other viruses is very important for the health and well-being of the whole Slade community. We are closely monitoring all COVID-19 virus information and recommendations and have been in contact with the Archdiocese and local health department to make sure we are doing all we can to be prepared and stay healthy.

Please help us keep Slade healthy by following these community recommendations from the CDC and NASN (National Association of School Nurses):

- Stay home when you are sick. If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick. You will help prevent others from catching your illness. Avoid close contact with people who are sick. *Children must be fever-free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or Motrin before returning to school. If your child seems sick, keep them home!*
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth. Germs spread this way.
- **Cover coughs and sneezes**. Use a tissue to cover coughs and sneezes, then dispose of the tissue. When a tissue is not available, cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- **Clean and disinfect surfaces or objects**. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home, work or school, especially when someone is ill. In addition to the cleaning of bathrooms, doorknobs, and banisters we do every day, we will also be wiping down all classrooms with disinfectant wipes at the end of every day. If you are able, please send in extra disinfecting wipes!
- Wash hands for 20 seconds. Washing hands often under clean, running water can help prevent the spread of germs. If you cannot wash your hands, use alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60-95% alcohol.
