

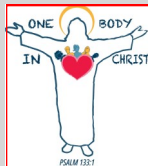

**Morning Drop-off Reminders** - Please remember that if you are entering the campus by way of the drive between the armory and the cafeteria, all traffic should stay to the right side of the drive and outside the coned area.
