Important News & Notes:

Parking Lot Safety Reminders: There are several safety issues occurring during the day which we feel the need to address.

- After 8:00 a.m. there are no adults on the lot to supervise students being dropped off; therefore, parents need to park and walk their child(ren) up to the front door.
- During afternoon dismissal, students are not permitted to walk down the side stairs to the cafeteria area for pick up there or at the armory. All students must be picked up from the main parking lot in the afternoon, with the exception of children enrolled in the after-care program who are dismissed from the cafeteria. Recently, several students have been observed to get into vehicles that are parking at the armory and outside the cafeteria. Because that area is not supervised by Slade personnel, students may not be in those areas.
- Please remember that the access road that runs between the cafeteria and the armory is a **one-way** street. Cars should not drive down in the opposite directions as there is no stop sign or traffic light to help control the flow of traffic.
- If pets are brought to school during drop-off or pick-up, they must remain in their owner's vehicle. Even if leashed, they may not be out of a vehicle.

Per the Parent & Student Handbook, p. 49 - Afternoon Parking/Dismissal Procedure: Parents are reminded that the following procedures are designed with the safety of all in mind. Therefore, please be diligent in following these guidelines, as you are a role model for your children. (NOTE: Parents are not allowed to park in the Parish Center parking area, the Edu-Care lot or the Armory parking lot during Slade dismissal. In addition, parents are asked to refrain from bringing their pets to school as it is a distraction to the dismissal procedure.)


