Dear Parents,

Earlier this week, you received a letter from the Chancellor of Education regarding school safety. I want you to be aware of what we have done in the past and what we are doing now to ensure the continued safety and security of our students and staff.

Two summers ago, our emergency procedures and campus were evaluated by a professional trained in active-shooter situations. From that evaluation, we were able to make improvements to our emergency plan. Since then, we have continued to review and enhance procedures. We regularly conduct practice drills with the students and staff. Due to recent events, this week we invited another professional, who is trained in assessing threats and vulnerabilities of buildings and grounds, to visit Monsignor Slade to reassess our security measures. Based on his visit, we were reassured to learn that our plan and facility are in good shape; although, we will be incorporating some of his recommendations.

We hope that none of these plans would ever need to be implemented, but we understand their necessity and the continued need to be ever-vigilant.


