 2022. Enrollment agreements for all students should have been completed by March 15, 2022
- Once enrollment agreements for all students in the family are complete, proceed to FACTS to activate your 2022-2023 account. All FACTS accounts must be activated by May 1, 2022.
- Any FACTS account which is inactive as of May 2, 2022, will be assessed a \$100 late-processing fee.
- All other checklist items or updated enrollment materials should be submitted as the coming school year nears.
- Current students who have not re-registered will be assessed a late re-registration fee of \$100 per student. These fees will be applied to the student's enrollment agreement for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Terrapin Times:

Next week, Poppy will be spending two days at the National Aquarium in Baltimore to be PIT (Passive Integrated Transponder) tagged. The PIT tag will be injected internally under Poppy's skin by the National Aquarium Animal Health staff. About the size of a grain of rice, the PIT tag consists of inert wire, a chip, and capacitor encased in glass. Tagging is a mandatory part of the National Aquarium's Terrapins in the Classroom program. All the terrapins are tagged so that, should they return to Poplar Island, they can be scanned and identified. The information is used to support terrapin population studies.
