2023-2024 Enrollment Deadline: Saturday, April 1, 2023

Tomorrow marks the deadline for submission of 2023-2024 Enrollment Agreements and activation of 2023-2024 FACTS tuition payment accounts. Any student whose enrollment agreement is not complete nor has an activated FACTS account by **April 1, 2023** will be placed on a waiting list and incur a penalty fee for late enrollment. All other checklist items or updated enrollment materials will be requested as the coming school year nears.

Waitlists have formed in Pre-K2, Pre-K3 (full-day), Pre-K4, Kindergarten, 1st, 7th and 8th Grades. We anticipate waitlists forming in 6th Grade, too. Please share this information with any family you refer to our school.

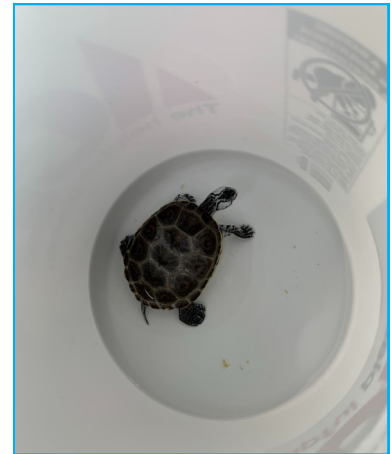
