Directions: Route 170 towards Odenton. Proceed through the 175/170 intersection. Take a left at the next traffic light onto Odenton Road. This will bring you behind the skating rink. Wheels is approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile on the left at the top of the hill. You can also enter from Rt. 175 and go up the hill across from the Dairy Queen.
