Scantron Testing for Grades 2-8: The spring administration of the Scantron Performance Assessment will begin the Monday we return from Easter break, April 25, 2022. <u>The schedule that was released last week has been revised</u>. Please see the attached revised schedule for the days when your child(ren) will be assessed.

Criteria for instructional groups consists of the following: standardized testing, end-ofyear/algebra placement tests (for 7th grade only), progress reports, teacher recommendations, and class performance (work habits, motivation, maturity). In order for students to be on track for the correct math grouping in high school, the standardized test scores, particularly for math, will hold the most weight in the grouping process. The results of the IATT Algebra Readiness Test will also carry much weight for our upcoming 8th grade students. These criteria may result in a change in grouping for some students.

Crowning of Mary: The crowning of Mary our Queen is a traditional Roman Catholic ritual held during the month of May, and is likewise a favored tradition here at Monsignor Slade. The queen symbol was attributed to Mary because she was a perfect follower of Christ, who is the absolute "crown" of creation. She is the Mother of the Son of God, the Mother of Christ. It is a solemn procession, and at its close a statue of the Blessed Virgin is crowned with a garland or crown of flowers honoring Mary as "the Queen of May."



This year, the May Procession and Crowning of Mary will take place on Monday, May 2nd. In order to have fresh flowers to place at the statue of Mary throughout the month of May, the following schedule for buddy classes to bring in flowers has been established:
