





- Each Parent creates an account for ordering and payment
- The lunches are **prepared each morning** in the Main & Market kitchen.
- Each lunch is individually wrapped and labeled
- The lunches are **delivered to your school** in one of our 12 vans by a professional driver.

### **Giving back**

A portion of the Main & Market proceeds can be donated back to each participating school. Many schools use the Main & Market program as a significant fundraiser for school activities. Every time a parent places an order, a portion of the proceeds may be paid back to the participating school each month.
