Important News & Notes:

COVID Update: Yesterday, all families should have received a school-wide communication regarding the cases in our school. The Department of Catholic Schools is working closely with us and is aware of the number of cases and in which classes they are occurring. Any decision regarding the flipping of a class or the whole school to a virtual status will come from the DoCS; that is not a local school decision. Currently, we have 24 positive cases among students and staff. While we encourage masking as a deterrent to the spread, as has been the case, masking is at the discretion of parents. If students are absent during this time, parents, please contact your child's teacher, and review either the homework website or the Google Classroom for missed assignments.

8th Grade Benefit Concert - RESCHEDULED Date - Friday, May 20th:

Next Friday, May 20th, MSCS will present the 8th Grade Benefit concert, "Pause 4 Paws". Weather permitting, it will be held in the faculty parking lot from 4-7 p.m. Attendees are encouraged to bring lawn chairs to watch the concert. We will have guest bands as well as many 8th graders performing. There will be face-painting and dog toy-making booths for the children. 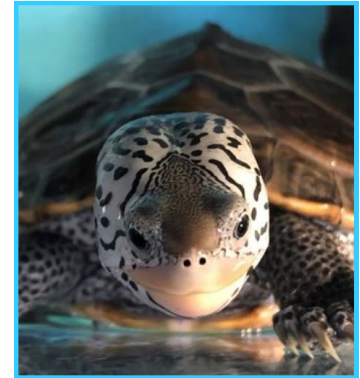

Grant them strength and courage in their daily assignments.*

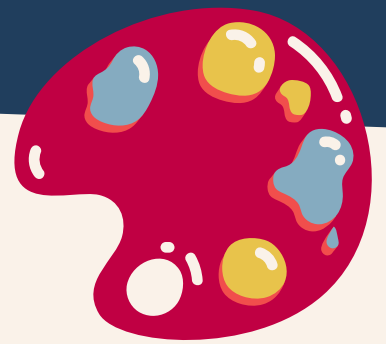
