- Attention Parents: Please be reminded that all debts to the school (including tuition, service hours, library books, textbooks, etc.) were due by May 15th in order for your student to receive final evaluations, transcripts, yearbooks, etc. For further details on the school's financial policies, see page 34 of the Parent & Student Handbook. - Cafeteria End-of-Year Info The last day that lunches will be served and/or sold in the cafeteria is Wednesday, May 31st. After May 31st, ALL students must bring a bagged lunch with drink to school for the remainder of the school year. If you are currently carrying a negative balance on your Tommy's account, please make sure to send in your check or make a payment online as soon as possible.

• **New Uniform Company:** As you know, we are changing uniform companies for the 2017-2018 school year. We are pleased to announce that we are partnering with FlynnO'Hara Uniforms, a local store that is within a few miles of MSCS.

There are a few changes to the uniform for next year:

- o Boys in grades 6-8 will wear khaki pants that must be purchased from FlynnO'Hara Uniforms.
- Our gym uniform will feature the new school logo, rather than the roadrunner logo used in the past. The gym t-shirts and sweatshirts will be a darker grey. We will also offer a zipper-front hoodie as an additional option for the gym uniform.
- Girls in grades K-8 will also have the option of wearing khaki slacks, purchased from FlynnO'Hara. If they choose to wear the slacks during the winter months, they must wear the school sweater or vest (available in red for grades 6-8 or green for grades K-5) as part of their uniform.

The old gym uniform and/or middle school boys grey slacks may still be worn over the next three years as part of a "phase-in" process. Please see the flyer attached for further details and pricing information.

• **Used Uniform Exchange/Sale:** As in years past, the school will hold a used uniform exchange/sale during the last week of school. Since the children come to school out of uniform that week, this is a good opportunity for parents to donate old uniforms. Please note: The used uniform committee will no longer accept uniforms with the old logo (rocking cross). The exchange will be held on June 6th from 4-6:30 p.m. If you are not ready to purchase uniforms for the coming school year, you can still donate at this time. Simply keep track of your donations and attend the late summer used uniform sale, which will be held on August 15th. Your child will not be able to begin seventh grade without having these additional vaccines. When your child receives the vaccinations, please make sure to provide a copy of the immunization to the school. You may upload the immunization records through your School Admin portal, or send a copy to Mrs. Stacey Kripas, School Registrar. 
