Dear Monsignor Slade staff, teachers, and students,

We, Operation Mato Grosso volunteers, extend our sincerest thank you to all who supported our very successful 2022 Food Drive.

Thanks to you and to the support of fourteen other Catholic churches and four schools, we collected over 100,000 pounds of food and



about \$15,000 in monetary donations in just two months. A special thanks to all the teenagers who spent their Saturdays and Sundays in front of supermarkets collecting food. This year, we had more than 50 teenagers and young adults who have come to help our 4 youth groups! We cannot express our deep gratitude for all your support. We still can't believe it! We will ship the container in the next two weeks, which will arrive in the port of Lima, Peru by mid-June. The food will be served to





people in many South American communities – in our schools, parishes' soup kitchens, orphanages, hospitals, clinics, and more – to feed those who go without or cannot provide for themselves.


REMINDER:
