### **Grade Level Reminders:**

- **Seventh Grade** All students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade must have one additional Tdap and one meningococcal vaccination when they begin school in the fall. Notification was sent in February to give sufficient time to contact your child's doctor and schedule these immunizations. This is just a reminder of these additional immunization requirements. Once your child has received the additional vaccinations, please provide proof to the school no later than August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

### About the Camp

How can you launch a rocket with a chemical reaction? How can you build, and program, a robot to follow instructions? How does your hand provide valuable security information? All these questions and more will be answered at Archbishop Spalding's Cavalier Engineering Camp.

Designed for rising 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students, the Cavalier Engineering Camp explores a variety of engineering concepts and careers through hands-on projects and experiential learning. The camp introduces participants to engineering in a fun and exciting environment. Participation takes place under the guidance of Archbishop Spalding High School Project Lead the Waytm engineering students and faculty, serving as camp counselors.

The Cavalier Engineering Camp operates in our state of the art engineering lab featuring 3D printer and software, VEX Robotics kits (with computer programming interfaces and software), and specialized project build and test areas. Each day of camp is divided into a morning and an afternoon session featuring a particular engineering career field including a hands-on project.
