

Financial Aid! BOOST Application Deadline Extended! The Maryland State Department of Education offers the BOOST Awards for families who wish to send their children to private school. All families who have received BOOST funding in the past MUST reapply each year to continue to receive that award. The new application deadline is now July 15, 2020, until midnight (12:00 a.m.).
