Grade Level Reminders:

Incoming Kindergarten for Fall 2023 - Before your child starts school in the fall, please provide updated vaccination records for your child that show two (2) MMR vaccines and two (2) Varicella vaccines, as well as a completed Health Inventory and Parent Observation Form. We ask that you forward these items to Joanna Buchanan, Registrar, at j.buchanan@msladeschool.com as soon as possible. Both forms can be found on our school website, www.msladeschool.com. Incoming Seventh Grade for Fall 2023 - Please be reminded that it is mandatory for all incoming seventh graders to have one additional TDap and one meningococcal vaccination before school begins in the fall. Required Immunizations

For the 2023-2024 school year, there are new immunization requirements for children.

- All students entering kindergarten through grade 7 must have had TWO varicella vaccinations.
- All students entering grades 7-12 must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.

These new requirements are <u>in addition to the existing school immunization requirements</u>.

Existing requirements:

Kindergarten, Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:

- DTaP/DTP/DT/Td 3 doses
- Polio 3 doses
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- Varicella 2 doses
- Hepatitis B 3 doses

Grade 7 & 8 ONLY:

- Tdap 1 dose
- Meningococcal 1 dose

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the *Maryland Recommended Childhood Immunization*.



If you would like the optional packet to be charged to your FACTS account as well, you must contact Mrs. Sullivan at k.sullivan@msladeschool.com by July 21, 2023. The cost will then be added to your FACTS account for payment on August 1, 2023.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **headphones to use in the Computer Lab.** Your child's headphones will be labeled with his/her name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Computer Lab. The headphones are used through 2nd grade at Monsignor Slade. Students in grades 3 -8 may continue to use the purchased headphones or may use ear buds purchased on their own. Also, due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **safety goggles to use in the Science Lab.** Safety goggles will be labeled with the student's name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Science Lab. Goggles are supplied in the 6th grade and are used throughout the student's middle school years at Slade.

* Packet item will be distributed by the teacher

** Included in the cost of the packet for grades 4-8, there is a novel fee for required reading. The cost of these novel fees are as follows: Grade 4 - \$5.00, Grade 5 - \$11.00, Grade 6 - \$19.00, Grade 7 - \$19.00, Grade 8 - \$18.00. This money is collected at the time your packet is purchased; however, the novels will be distributed by your student's teacher.

Included in the required packet for grades 4 - 8 is a **Science Lab fee** used to offset supplies used in the Science Lab. The cost is as follows: grades 4 & 5 - \$3.00, grades 6, 7 and 8 - \$6.00.

Referral Program

Monsignor Slade Catholic School sponsors a family referral program, "Spirit of Slade," which rewards the families of currently enrolled full-day Pre-K—7th grade families who refer new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School.



- Open to all MSCS families with students currently enrolled in full day Pre-K2 through 7th grade
- For every new family that lists your family's name in the "Referred by" field on their enrollment application and completes one full year of school at MSCS, your family will receive a **\$500** tuition credit for the following school year.
- Tuition credits are awarded on a per *FAMILY*, not per student, basis.
- You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total tuition rate for one student in a family in any given year. Credits will not be applied until a family's FACTS account is activated for the year in which the credits are to be received. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.



To help as you refer new families:

- A new family is defined as a family NOT currently enrolled in the Edu-Care program/Pre-K2-8th grades at MSCS.
- Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.
