**2022-2023 School Hours:** Monsignor Slade's doors will open at 7:30 a.m. for students to enter. They will proceed directly to homerooms. Middle school students will begin class at 7:45 a.m., and classes for grades K-5 will begin at 8:00 a.m. Middle school will be considered late after 7:43 a.m., and grades K-5 will be considered late after 8 a.m. Pre-K4 will be considered late after 8:15 a.m. Dismissal will take place at 2:45 p.m.

**Uniforms:** Last year, uniform compliance was not a priority; keeping students in school took precedence. Some students fell into sloppy uniform habits. Homeroom teachers will remind students in all grades of uniform and general appearance expectations throughout the year. We ask for your help and partnership in enforcing these expectations daily.

Used Uniform Exchange: Our next used uniform sale/exchange will be held on August 24, 2022, from 3:30-6:30 p.m. in the multi-purpose room (MPR). If you are bringing uniforms to exchange that day, please launder them. If you are not attending the exchange but have uniforms that you would like to donate, please drop them off at school Monday-Thursday between the hours of 8:00a.m.-1:00 p.m. before August 11, 2022. Please remember that we are no longer accepting any uniforms that have the old rocking cross or roadrunner logos.

Main & Market School Lunch Program: Attached you will find information regarding our new lunch service. We want you to have time over the summer to familiarize yourself with the new lunch-ordering process. Please be aware that lunch for your child(ren) is ordered in advance by the month. There will be no food items available for sale on a daily basis. The first open ordering date for the month of September is August 1st and the end date to order for September is August 21st. We hope that you and your family will be pleased with the addition of a school lunch program for the 2022-2023 school year.

**School Supplies List:** Attached you will find the school supplies list for the 2022-2023 school year. Please be reminded that the cost of the required school supplies packet for each student will be charged to your family's FACTS account. Should you wish to purchase the optional packet and have it billed to your FACTS account as well, please contact Mrs. Sullivan by July 22, 2021, at <u>k.sullivan@msladeschool.com</u>. Please refer to the top of the school supplies list for packet pick-up information. Optional packets will be available for purchase in the school bookstore on August 25, 2022, from 5:30-6:45 p.m.

The school supplies packet for your child(ren) contains the MSDE Emergency Form, which is required to be completed, signed by the parent, and submitted to the school for each student attending Monsignor Slade. The form is printed on blue card stock, so you should be able to find it easily among your child's supplies when you pick up their packet. Please be sure to submit the emergency form on August 25 to your child's teacher. If you are unable to attend the Ice Cream Social, please send the card to the school on your child's second day.

**Service Hours Program Information:** The Service Hours Program is a great way to become involved in your child's education. Each family with students enrolled in Pre-K4 (full-day) through 8th grade is required to give twelve (12) of service during the school year or pay an additional fee of \$300 by December 31, 2022. You will be able to sign up electronically. Look for the sign-up information in the August 5th parent update. There are several opportunities to chair events, which would enable you to earn all of your service hours for the school year. **Incoming Kindergarten for Fall 2022** - Before your child starts school in the fall, please provide updated vaccination records for your child that show two (2) MMR vaccines and two (2) Varicella vaccines, as well as a completed Health Inventory and Parent Observation Form. **Incoming Seventh Grade for Fall 2022** - Please be reminded that it is mandatory for all incoming seventh graders to have one additional TDap and one meningococcal vaccination before school begins in the fall. When your child receives the vaccinations, please make sure to provide a copy of the immunization to the school registrar as soon as possible so that we can update his or her record before the start of the school year. Copies of the immunization record can either be sent to the office by fax to 410-787-0594, or you can email it to the school registrar, Mrs. Joanna Buchanan, at j.buchanan@msladeschool.com.

#### From the School Nurse:

#### **Required Immunizations**

For the 2022-2023 school year, there are new immunization requirements for children.

- All students entering kindergarten through grade 7 must have had TWO varicella vaccinations.
- All students entering grades 7-12 must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.

These new requirements are in addition to the existing school immunization requirements.

#### Existing requirements

Kindergarten, Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:

- DTaP/DTP/DT/Td 3 doses
- Polio 3 doses
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- Varicella 2 doses
- Hepatitis B 3 doses

Grade 7 & 8 ONLY:

- Tdap 1 dose
- Meningococcal 1 dose

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the *Maryland Recommended Childhood Immunization*.

## School Uniform Shoes for 2022-2023:

## There are only four uniform shoe styles approved to wear with the school uniform.

The following three shoe styles may be purchased from a private vendor (note the style name and color listed below), or they may be purchased from our uniform supplier, FlynnOHara Uniform:



Bass oxford shoe – Style name - "Dirty Buc Oxford Shoe" and authorized color - "Taupe" in kid's sizes and "Dirty Buc" in men's and women's sizes.



Merrell slip-on shoe – Style name - "Jungle Moc Nubuck" and authorized color - "Brown Nubuck"



Sperry – Style name - "Authentic Original Boat Shoe" and authorized color – "Sahara," available in men, women and kid sizes.

The fourth approved uniform shoe is also a Sperry shoe style, but it is only available through a private vendor. You will note that the shoe style and color names change slightly, depending on the size needed:



- b) Big Kid's Songfish Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."
- c) Big Kid's Songfish Jr. Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."
- d) Little Kid's Songfish Jr. in "Linen Oat."
- e) Men's Billfish Boat Shoe in "Tan Beige" or "Dark Tan."
- f) Women's Koifish Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."
- g) Women's Songfish Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."

All approved Sperry shoes must be either two-eyed or three-eyed boat shoes. The oneeyed shoes, referred to as "moccasins," are not an approved style for safety purposes.

If you would prefer, you may pre-pay the cost of the optional packet by having it charged to your FACTS account. **If you would like the optional packet to be charged to your FACTS account as well, you must contact Mrs. Sullivan by July 21, 2022.** The cost will then be added to your FACTS account for payment on August 1, 2022.

#### PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **headphones to use in the Computer Lab.** Your child's headphones will be labeled with his/her name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Computer Lab. The headphones are used through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade at Monsignor Slade. Students in grades 3 -8 may continue to use the purchased headphones or may use ear buds purchased on their own. Also, due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **safety goggles to use in the Science Lab.** Safety goggles will be labeled with the student's name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Science Lab. Goggles are supplied in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade and are used throughout the student's middle school years at Slade.

**\*\*** Included in the cost of the packet for grades 4-8, there is a novel fee for required reading. The cost of these novel fees are as follows: Grade 4 - \$9.00, Grade 5 - \$12.00, Grade 6 - \$17.00, Grade 7 - \$22.00, Grade 8 - \$22.00. This money is collected at the time your packet is purchased; however, the novels will be distributed by your student's teacher.

Included in the required packet for grades 6, 7 & 8 is a \$6.00 Science Lab fee used to offset supplies used in the Science Lab.
