Important News & Notes:

AOB Theme for 2021-2022- Year of the Eucharist: As we emerge from this global pandemic, it is imperative that we renew our perspective on how the Mass and the Eucharist are foundational to our Faith. Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, the treasure of Church, is the source and summit of the Christian life. The Eucharist is the source of all grace and Jesus' Real Presence in our lives is the ultimate answer to the anxiety, uncertainty, and division we see so pervasive in our present circumstances. To highlight the mystery of the



Eucharist, Archbishop Lori asked that we, as an Archdiocesan family, observe a "Year of the Eucharist" during the 12-month period from the Solemnity of Corpus Christi this year (June 6, 2021) until the Solemnity of Corpus Christi next year. The theme is "Encounter Christ's Presence" and it is intended to invite us all into a deeper reflection on our relationship with Jesus Christ through all the ways the Church teaches that the Lord is present in the Mass: in the Word proclaimed; in the Congregation; in the Minister (Priest); and in the Eucharistic species itself (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*, §7).

E-cycle Your Unused Devices Next Week! On July, 20, 2021, we will host an e-cycling day for our families courtesy of Forever Green Recycle. If you have any electronics (other than televisions) that you are no longer using, and you would like us to recycle them for you, please feel free to stop by school on July 20 anytime before 2 p.m. to make your donation. The truck will be here from 11-2; however, if you would like to drop off donations earlier that morning, they can be placed at the carport area. (See flyer attached for a listing of acceptable items.) Thank you for helping to support our green efforts!!

2021-2022 School Hours: We will resume normal arrival hours for the fall! Monsignor Slade's doors will open at 7:30 a.m. for students to enter. They will proceed directly to homerooms. Middle school students will begin class at 7:45 a.m., and classes for grades K-5 will begin at 8:00 a.m. Middle school will be considered late after 7:43 a.m., and grades K-5 will be considered late after 8 a.m. Pre-K4 will be considered late after 8:15 a.m. Dismissal will begin at 2:45 p.m.

At-Home Devices for Next Year Reminder: We want to make families aware now that Chromebooks will not be sent home next year for student use. When the one-to-one Chromebook initiative was first instituted, it was intended that the devices be used only at school. The urgency of COVID circumstances dictated the necessity for us to allow them to be sent home. Unfortunately, the wear and tear experienced this year resulting in many repairs and replacement of parts was very costly for both families and the school. If you do not already have a home device that your student would use in the event of absences due to quarantine, general illnesses, etc., you may want to consider making arrangements to secure a home device for the 21-22 school year.

Uniforms: Last year, uniform compliance was not a priority, keeping students in school took precedence. Some students fell into sloppy uniform habits. Homeroom teachers will remind students in all grades of uniform and general appearance expectations at the beginning of the year. We will resume the wearing of the belts for grades K-8 and ties for middle school boys. We ask for your help and partnership in enforcing these expectations!

School Supplies List: Attached you will find the school supplies list for the 2021-2022 school year. This year, the school supplies packet contains the MSDE Emergency Form, which is required to be completed, signed by the parent, and submitted to the school for each student attending Monsignor Slade. The form is printed on yellow card stock, so you should be able to find it easily among your child's supplies when you pick up his/her packet. Please be sure to submit the emergency form to the school on your child's first day.

Service Hours Program Announcement: The Service Hours Program has been reinstated for the 2021-2022 school year. The Service Hours Program is a great way to become involved in your child's education. Each family with students enrolled in Pre-K4 (full-day) through 8th grade is required to give twelve (12) hours of service during the school year or pay an additional fee of \$300 by December 31, 2021. This year, families will be able to sign up electronically. The sign-up information will be distributed the first week of August. There are several opportunities to chair events, which would enable you to earn all of your service hours for the school year. The hospitality committee is in need of a chairperson, or co-chairpersons, and there are several other chairperson opportunities available through the Home and School Association. School Uniform Shoes for 2021-2022:

There are only four uniform shoe styles approved to wear with the school uniform.

The following three shoe styles may be purchased from a private vendor (note the style name and color listed below), or they may be purchased from our uniform supplier, FlynnOHara Uniform:



Bass oxford shoe – Style name - "Dirty Buc Oxford Shoe" and authorized color - "Taupe" in kid's sizes and "Dirty Buc" in men's and women's sizes.



Merrell slip-on shoe – Style name - "Jungle Moc Nubuck" and authorized color - "Brown Nubuck"



Sperry – Style name - "Authentic Original Boat Shoe" and authorized color – "Sahara," available in men, women and kid sizes.

The fourth approved uniform shoe is also a Sperry shoe style, but it is only available through a private vendor. You will note that the shoe style and color names change slightly, depending on the size needed:



- b) Big Kid's Songfish Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."
- c) Big Kid's Songfish Jr. Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."
- d) Little Kid's Songfish Jr. in "Linen Oat."
- e) Men's Billfish Boat Shoe in "Tan Beige" or "Dark Tan."
- f) Women's Koifish Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."
- g) Women's Songfish Boat Shoe in "Linen Oat."

All approved Sperry shoes must be either two-eyed or three-eyed boat shoes. The one-eyed shoes, referred to as "moccasins," are not an approved style for safety purposes.

Due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **headphones to use in the Computer Lab.** Your child's headphones will be labeled with his/her name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Computer Lab. The headphones are used through 2nd grade at Monsignor Slade. Students in grades 3 -8 may continue to use the purchased headphones or may use ear buds purchased on their own. Also, due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **safety goggles to use in the Science Lab.** Safety goggles will be labeled with the student's name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Science Lab. Goggles are supplied in the 6th grade and are used throughout the student's middle school years at Slade.

** Included in the cost of the packet for grades 4-8, there is a novel fee for required reading. The cost of these novel fees are as follows: Grade 4 - \$9.00, Grade 5 - \$10.00, Grade 6 - \$16.00, Grade 7 - \$20.00, Grade 8 - \$17.00. This money is collected at the time your packet is purchased; however, the novels will be distributed by your student's teacher.

Included in the required packet for grades 6, 7 & 8 is a \$6.00 **Science Lab fee** used to offset supplies used in the Science Lab.
