Please note: You may not volunteer in any activity in which you may come in contact with children until the process is complete and you are VIRTUS-compliant..

Getting Started with Heaven Sent Catering’s Online Ordering System

Welcome to Heaven Sent Catering LLC.'s lunch ordering site. We hope you will find ordering lunches to be easy and intuitive. You will find below step-by-step instructions for getting started.

Start by logging in to: <https://heavensentcateringllc.h1.hotlunchonline.net/>. Next, click on the *Student* tab (top left), then click on *Create a new Student*. Select your School. Select your Student's Grade from the dropdown box. Enter their first name and last name and click *Submit*. Your student account has been created.

For families with multiple students, please repeat the above process for each child.

To order lunches, click on the *Order* tab (top left). Make your selections by clicking on the Entrée name, reviewing the meal description, and then clicking *Add to Cart*. The Entrée you selected will turn green, indicating it is in your cart. You may also click *Add All Similar* to add all similar items to your cart.

Families with multiple students may order for each student by highlighting each name. The names are listed on the upper left hand side of the screen. You may order and pay for all students at once. You do not need to log in and out for each student.

Once you have made your selections and are happy with your order, it's time to pay. Click on the *Checkout* button, in the bottom right hand corner of your screen. The next screen to appear will show you a summary of which lunches you bought and for whom. When you have reviewed your order and are satisfied, click *Pay Now*. If you review your order and see a change you would like to make, click *Make Changes*.

After you click *Pay Now*, you will be sent to a secure checkout page, where you will finish your transaction by entering your credit card information.

You will want to make sure you have your correct email address on file. In the event that you forget your Hot Lunch Account password, your email address is used to ensure your identity in the password resetting process. We do not store a human readable version of your password in our system, so please do not contact Heaven Sent Catering LLC. to retrieve your password. Instead, use the "Forgot my Password" link on the sign in page.

VIRTUS Instructions for Volunteers

Monsignor Slade Catholic School and the Archdiocese of Baltimore have a commitment to maintaining the trust of the faithful by providing our children and youth with safe environments characterized by healthy relationships. With our longstanding commitment in mind, all parishes and archdiocesan Catholic schools use *VIRTUS*, a compliance management system that allows all parishes and schools to facilitate compliance with archdiocesan child protection requirements for all volunteers who work with minors, employees, and clergy.

Monsignor Slade Catholic School is required to comply with the Archdiocesan Children and Youth Training Program, which requires all volunteers ages 18 and over who have contact with children to complete the following program prior to being allowed to volunteer:

- **Register as a MSCS volunteer at www.virtusonline.org**
 1. Select *First-Time Registrant*
 2. Select *Begin the Registration Process*
 3. Choose "Baltimore (Archdiocese)" from the pull-down menu. Click *Select*
 4. Create your own User-ID and password. Click *Continue*.
 5. Application Information: Complete all required fields
 6. Select Primary Location from pull-down menu. Click *Continue*
 7. You will be asked, "Do you work or volunteer in another location?" If you will be serving at another location(s), select additional location(s).
 8. Select the role by clicking on "Volunteer With Substantial Contact with Children" for your volunteer service at Monsignor Slade. Click all roles that apply to additional service within the Archdiocese of Baltimore.
 9. Describe your role such as parent volunteer, coach, etc. Click *Continue*.
 10. Answer next 2 questions. NOTE: Monsignor Slade **does not** have volunteers drive as part of any position. Click *Continue*.
 11. Answer next 3 questions. Click *Continue*.
 12. You will be asked to view the Archdiocese of Baltimore's child and youth protection policies: *A Statement of Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth* and the *Code of Conduct for Church Personnel of the Archdiocese of Baltimore*. You will be asked to answer questions about the policies.
 13. Click box stating, "I hereby represent that I have downloaded, read, and understand this document."
 14. Provide electronic signature and date. Click *Continue*.
 15. Answer next 10 questions.
 16. Enter information for 3 references, one personal, one family, and one professional. Include for each a mailing address, phone number, email address, how long you have known the person and your relationship to the person. NOTE: If you include email addresses, the reference check will be sent via email. Otherwise, it will be sent via USPS.
 17. Select training session you wish to complete. Click *Complete Registration*.
 18. Complete Background Check. Once you close the Background Check Screen, you will be taken automatically to the online training course.
 19. Click on the green circle to begin the online training course.

Once the online process has been completed and all of the references checks have been returned from the references, you will receive notification of completion and you may begin to volunteer.

School Uniform Shoes for 2023-2024:

There are only four uniform shoe styles approved to wear with the school uniform.

The following three shoe styles may be purchased from a private vendor (note the style name and color listed below), or they may be purchased from our uniform supplier, FlynnOHara Uniform:



Bass oxford shoe – Style name - “Dirty Buc Oxford Shoe” and authorized color - “Taupe” in kid’s sizes and “Dirty Buc” in men’s and women’s sizes.



Merrell slip-on shoe – Style name - “Jungle Moc Nubuck” and authorized color - “Brown Nubuck”



Sperry – Style name - “Authentic Original Boat Shoe” and authorized color – “Sahara,” available in men, women and kid sizes.

The fourth approved uniform shoe is also a Sperry shoe style, but it is only available through a private vendor. You will note that the shoe style and color names change slightly, depending on the size needed:



- b) Big Kid’s Songfish Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”
- c) Big Kid’s Songfish Jr. Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”
- d) Little Kid’s Songfish Jr. in “Linen Oat.”
- e) Men’s Billfish Boat Shoe in “Tan Beige” or “Dark Tan.”
- f) Women’s Koifish Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”
- g) Women’s Songfish Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”

All approved Sperry shoes must be either two-eyed or three-eyed boat shoes. The one-eyed shoes, referred to as “moccasins,” are not an approved style for safety purposes.

Due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **headphones to use in the Computer Lab**. - ◆ Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.
