Main & Market School Lunch Program: Attached you will find the information needed to sign up and order through our new lunch service. You do not need to order lunch every day in order for your child to participate. Just to make you aware, the school lunch does not include a drink. Since the only drink offered in the program is bottled water and we have water bottle fill stations throughout the building, we opted not to include the added expense. In addition, please note that there will be no food items available for purchase in the cafeteria. Lunch for your child(ren) is ordered in advance on a monthly basis. The September menu is posted and ready for ordering. Please note that the end date to order lunch for September is August 21st. We are very excited to have hot lunch available for our students and hope that you and your family are able to take advantage of this new program.

Ice Cream Social Reservations! Our annual back-to-school ice cream social for Pre-K4-8th grade families will be held on August 25, 2022, from 6:15-7:00 pm on the carport. A new twist to this evening for 1st-8th grade students will include a sneak peek at your child's classroom where you will also pick up your child's school supply packet from 5:30-6:15 p.m! If you are unable to attend, your child will receive his/her packet on the first day of school. Due to the need for accurate record-keeping, we will be unable to release packets to other families on your behalf.



Included in the school supplies packet is a blue emergency card. Please have your child's health information and emergency contact information available so that you can complete the blue card prior to heading to the ice cream social. It is most important that we have this information card in hand prior to the first day of school. Used Uniform Exchange: Our next used uniform sale/exchange will be held on August 24, 2022, from 3:30-6:30 p.m. in the multi-purpose room (MPR). If you are bringing uniforms to exchange that day, please launder them. If you are not attending the exchange but have uniforms that you would like to donate, please drop them off at school Monday-Thursday between the hours of 8:00a.m.-1:00 p.m. Please remember that we are no longer accepting any uniforms that have the old rocking cross or roadrunner logos.

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures: This fall, we will begin the year with normal drop-off times beginning at 7:30 a.m. Both the main entrance at the light on Dorsey Road and the Armory entrance by the cafeteria (for those only turning right off of Dorsey Road), will be open at drop-off.

There will be three drop-off lanes from the entrance at the light on Dorsey Road indicated by blue line markings. The first two lanes will be for any students in grades 2-8. The third line is reserved for students in grades Pre-K4-1 and any siblings/riders in their cars. Parents who will use that third line are asked to display a sign showing the grade level of the youngest child in the car so that staff will easily identify the line into which families will need to be directed. Safety patrols will be assigned to the Pre-K4-1st grade line to help escort those students needing assistance into the building. There is one drop-off lane for all grades if you enter from the Armory entrance.

Middle school students will be considered late if they enter the building after 7:43 a.m. as their classes begin at 7:45 a.m. Students in grades K-5 are considered late if they enter the building after 8:00 a.m., and Pre-K4 students are considered late if they enter after 8:15 a.m.

Students will exit their vehicles to the right and follow the yellow line to a yellow cone where they will be directed by a staff member as to when to cross. All students will enter through the carport doors.

If you need to drop off anything for the office or Extended Care, please park against the fence at the top of the parking lot and then walk to the side of the third drop-off lane in order to access the building.

For afternoon pick-up, we will resume the normal dismissal process with single-child car riders called first followed by multiple-child car riders. Therefore, only those who are picking up a single student may park in the first three rows closest to the Armory. If two or more children are being picked up, the three rows closest to the playground field must be used.

More detailed information about parking lot procedures will be forthcoming in the 2022-2023 Parent & Student Handbook. The handbook will be available on our website as of August 15, and you will receive a printed copy at the beginning of the school year.

Incoming Seventh Grade – Please be reminded that it is mandatory for all incoming 7th graders to have one additional TDap and one meningococcal vaccination before school begins on August 29th. If you have not already supplied this information to the school, please forward the updated immunization records to Joanna Buchanan, Registrar, at j.buchanan@mssladeschool.com, as soon as possible.
