

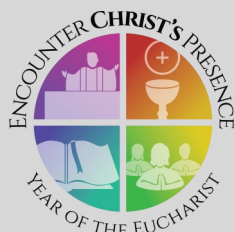

Uniforms: Last year, uniform compliance was not a priority; keeping students in school took precedence. Some students fell into sloppy uniform habits. Homeroom teachers will remind students in all grades of uniform and general appearance expectations at the beginning of the year. We will resume the wearing of the belts for grades K-8 and ties for middle school boys. We ask for your help and partnership in enforcing these expectations!

All new school uniform items, except for shoes, need to be purchased from FlynnO'Hara Uniforms located at 1608 Furnace Branch Rd, Glen Burnie, MD 21061, <https://www.flynnohara.com>. Attached you will find a listing of the approved uniform dress shoes for the 2021-2022 school year. Please remember that gym shoes may not have wheels or lights. Cafeteria Service: Currently, students will be required to bring their own bagged lunch and drink to school each day. The lunch must be peanut-free and one that does not require refrigeration or microwaving. Please remember that no energy drinks, coffee, or soft drinks are permitted. Milk will be provided for Pre-K4 students; all others students (grades K-8) must bring a drink from home. All students are requested to bring napkins with their lunches and to follow proper etiquette in the lunchroom.

Service Hours Program: The Service Hours Program has been reinstated for the 2021-2022 school year. The Service Hours Program is a great way to become involved in your child's education. Each family with students enrolled in Pre-K4 (full-day) through 8th grade is required to give twelve (12) of service during the school year or pay an additional fee of \$300 by December 31, 2021. This year, families will be able to sign up to work for events electronically. The sign-up information will be distributed by the end of this month. There are several opportunities to chair events, which would enable you to earn all of your service hours for the school year. From the School Nurse:

Health Forms

Upon entering Monsignor Slade Catholic School, students must have a complete physical and required immunizations. The physical must be completed within nine months prior to enrolling in school for the first time, or within six months after starting school for the first time. The Health Inventory form, which you will need to take with you to your child's physical, can be found in your School Admin portal.

Parents are also required to complete an MSDE Emergency Form, which will be included with your child's school supply packets. This form provides the Health Room with necessary information, including allergies, serious medical conditions, medications, and emergency contact information. Please ensure that the back of the form is completed and signed. The school must be notified of any changes that occur during the year.

Required Immunizations

For the 2021-2022 school year, there are new immunization requirements for children.

- All students entering kindergarten through grade 7 must have had TWO varicella vaccinations.
- All students entering grades 7-12 must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.

These new requirements are in addition to the existing school immunization requirements.

Existing requirements

- **Kindergarten, Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:**
 - ◇ DTaP/DTP/DT/Td - 3 doses
 - ◇ Polio - 3 doses
 - ◇ Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) - 2 doses
 - ◇ Varicella - 2 doses
 - ◇ Hepatitis B - 3 doses
- **Grade 7 & 8 ONLY:**
 - ◇ Tdap - 1 dose
 - ◇ Meningococcal - 1 dose

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the *Maryland Recommended Childhood Immunization Schedule*. *A child has up to 20 days from the start of school to show proof of vaccinations or that they have started a plan to get the missing immunizations.*

Medications At School

If a student's physician recommends that the student receive prescription or over-the-counter medication during the school day, a medication form signed by the student's licensed health care provider is required. **Forms are available on the Monsignor Slade Catholic School website and can be found under the Forms & Documents section of the Parents tab.** (Link to forms: <https://www.msladeschool.com/resources/forms-documents>) Medication, both prescription and non-prescription, can only be dispensed with this medication form, signed by the health care provider and parent, specifying start and stop dates.

ALL medications must be delivered to the school by the parent/guardian in their original boxes or containers. Medications delivered to the school nurse by the student will not be accepted for use, but will be placed in a locked cabinet until the parent/guardian picks up the medication or signs for it.

School Uniform Shoes for 2021-2022:

There are only four uniform shoe styles approved to wear with the school uniform.

The following three shoe styles may be purchased from a private vendor (note the style name and color listed below), or they may be purchased from our uniform supplier, FlynnOHara Uniform:



Bass oxford shoe – Style name - “Dirty Buc Oxford Shoe” and authorized color - “Taupe” in kid’s sizes and “Dirty Buc” in men’s and women’s sizes.



Merrell slip-on shoe – Style name - “Jungle Moc Nubuck” and authorized color - “Brown Nubuck”



Sperry – Style name - “Authentic Original Boat Shoe” and authorized color – “Sahara,” available in men, women and kid sizes.

The fourth approved uniform shoe is also a Sperry shoe style, but it is only available through a private vendor. You will note that the shoe style and color names change slightly, depending on the size needed:



- b) Big Kid’s Songfish Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”
- c) Big Kid’s Songfish Jr. Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”
- d) Little Kid’s Songfish Jr. in “Linen Oat.”
- e) Men’s Billfish Boat Shoe in “Tan Beige” or “Dark Tan.”
- f) Women’s Koifish Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”
- g) Women’s Songfish Boat Shoe in “Linen Oat.”

All approved Sperry shoes must be either two-eyed or three-eyed boat shoes. The one-eyed shoes, referred to as “moccasins,” are not an approved style for safety purposes.

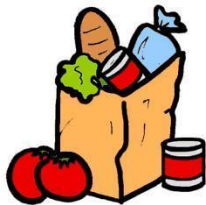
