#### **Grade Level Reminders:**

**Incoming Kindergarten for Fall 2023** - Before your child starts school in the fall, please provide updated vaccination records for your child that show two (2) MMR vaccines and two (2) Varicella vaccines, as well as a completed Health Inventory and Parent Observation Form. We ask that you forward these items to Joanna Buchanan, Registrar, at j.buchanan@msladeschool.com as soon as possible.

**Incoming Seventh Grade for Fall 2023** - Please be reminded that it is mandatory for all incoming seventh graders to have one additional TDap and one meningococcal vaccination before school begins in the fall. Copies of the immunization record can either be sent to the office by fax to 410-787-0594, or you can email it to the school registrar, Mrs. Joanna Buchanan, at <a href="mailto:j.buchanan@msladeschool.com">j.buchanan@msladeschool.com</a>, before the first day of school

# School

#### **Medications At School**

If a student's physician recommends that the student receive prescription or over-the-counter medication during the school day, a medication form signed by the student's licensed health care provider is required. Forms are available on the Slade website and can be found under the Forms & Documents section of the Parents tab.

Medication, both prescription and non-prescription, can only be dispensed with this medication form, signed by the health care provider and parent, specifying start and stop dates.

ALL medications must be delivered to the school by the parent/guardian in its original box or container. Medications delivered to the school nurse by the student will not be accepted for use, but will be placed in a locked cabinet until the parent/guardian picks up the medication or signs for it.

#### **Health Forms**

Upon entering Monsignor Slade Catholic School, students must have a complete physical and required immunizations. The physical must be completed within nine months prior

to enrolling in school for the first time, or within six months after starting school for the first time. The Health Inventory form, which is for Pre-K4 students only, should be taken with you to your child's physical. Students in kindergarten through 8th grade require the "Student Physical Form K-8." These forms can be found on the website as well using the following link: <a href="https://www.msladeschool.com/resources/forms-documents">https://www.msladeschool.com/resources/forms-documents</a> The form can be found in your School Admin portal.

Parents are also required to complete an MSDE Emergency Form, which will be included with your child's school supply packets. This year, the form is printed on orange card stock, and should be easily located within the packet. This important form provides the Health Room with necessary information, including allergies, serious medical conditions, medications, and emergency contact information. Please ensure that the back of the form is completed and signed. The school must be notified of any changes that occur during the year.

#### **Required Immunizations**

For the 2023-2024 school year, there are new immunization requirements for children.

- All students entering kindergarten through grade 7 must have had TWO varicella vaccinations.
- All students entering grades 7-12 must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.

These new requirements are in addition to the existing school immunization requirements.

Existing requirements

Kindergarten, Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:

- DTaP/DTP/DT/Td 3 doses
- Polio 3 doses
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- Varicella 2 doses
- Hepatitis B 3 doses

#### Grade 7 & 8 ONLY:

- Tdap 1 dose
- Meningococcal 1 dose

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the *Maryland Recommended Childhood Immunization*.

# Getting Started with Heaven Sent Catering's Online Ordering System

Welcome to Heaven Sent Catering LLC.'s lunch ordering site. We hope you will find ordering lunches to be easy and intuitive. You will find below step-by-step instructions for getting started.

Start by logging in to: <a href="https://heavensentcateringllc.h1.hotlunchonline.net/">https://heavensentcateringllc.h1.hotlunchonline.net/</a>. Next, click on the *Student* tab (top left), then click on *Create a new Student*. Select your School. Select your Student's Grade from the dropdown box. Enter their first name and last name and click *Submit*. Your student account has been created.

For families with multiple students, please repeat the above process for each child.

To order lunches, click on the *Order* tab (top left). Make your selections by clicking on the Entrée name, reviewing the meal description, and then clicking *Add to Cart*. The Entrée you selected will turn green, indicating it is in your cart. You may also click *Add All Similar* to add all similar items to your cart.

Families with multiple students may order for each student by highlighting each name. The names are listed on the upper left hand side of the screen. You may order and pay for all students at once. You do not need to log in and out for each student.

Once you have made your selections and are happy with your order, it's time to pay. Click on the *Checkout* button, in the bottom right hand corner of your screen. The next screen to appear will show you a summary of which lunches you bought and for whom. When you have reviewed your order and are satisfied, click *Pay Now*. If you review your order and see a change you would like to make, click *Make Changes*.

After you click *Pay Now*, you will be sent to a secure checkout page, where you will finish your transaction by entering your credit card information.

You will want to make sure you have your correct email address on file. In the event that you forget your Hot Lunch Account password, your email address is used to ensure your identity in the password resetting process. We do not store a human readable version of your password in our system, so please do not contact Heaven Sent Catering LLC. to retrieve your password. Instead, use the "Forgot my Password" link on the sign in page.
