Important News & Notes:

New Arrival and Dismissal Procedures: This fall there will not be a daily wellness survey for families, so we will resume normal drop-off times beginning at 7:30 a.m. and without a staggered entrance. Both the main entrance at the light on Dorsey Road and the Armory entrance by the cafeteria (for those only turning right off of Dorsey Road), will be open at drop-off.

There will be three drop-off lanes indicated by blue line markings. The first two lanes will be for any students in grades 2-8. The third line is reserved for students in grades Pre-K4-1 and any siblings/riders in their cars. Parents who will use that third line are asked to display a sign showing the grade level of the youngest child in the car so that staff will easily identify the line into which families will need to be directed. Safety patrols will be assigned to the Pre-K4-1st grade line to help escort those students needing assistance into the building.

Middle school students will be considered late if they enter the building after 7:43 a.m. as their classes begin at 7:45 a.m. Students in grades K-5 are considered late if they enter the building after 8:00 a.m., and Pre-K4 students are considered late if they enter after 8:15 a.m.

Students will exit their vehicles to the right and follow the yellow line to a yellow cone where they will be directed by a staff member as to when to cross. All students will enter through the carport doors.

If you need to drop off anything for the office or Extended Care, please park against the fence at the top of the parking lot and then walk to the side of the third drop-off lane in order to access the building.

For afternoon pick-up, we will resume our normal dismissal process with the single-child car riders called first followed by multiple-child car riders. Therefore, only those who are picking up a single student may park in the first three rows closest to the Armory. If two or more children are being picked up, the three rows closest to the playground field must be used.

More detailed information about parking lot procedures will be forthcoming in the 2021-2022 Parent & Student Handbook. The handbook will be available on our website as of August 12, and you will receive a printed copy at the beginning of the school year. In the meantime, please reference the two diagrams attached to this update.

Service Hours Program Update: The Service Hours Program has been reinstated for the 2021-2022 school year. Each family with students enrolled in Pre-K4 (full-day) through 8th grade is required to give twelve (12) hours of service during the school year or pay an additional fee of \$300 by December 31, 2021. This year, families will be able to sign up electronically. You will find further details about the Program and the sign-up link in the August 20th weekly update.

Please note: If you elect to chair an event, you will earn your complete service hours commitment of 12 hours per year. We are in need of a few people who might be inter-

At-Home Devices for Next Year Reminder: Please be reminded that Chromebooks will not be sent home next year for student use. When the one-to-one Chromebook initiative was first instituted, it was intended that the devices be used only at school. The urgency of COVID circumstances dictated the necessity for us to allow them to be sent home. Unfortunately, the wear and tear experienced this year resulting in many repairs and replacement of parts was very costly for both families and the school. If you do not already have a home device that your student would use in the event of absences due to quarantine, general illnesses, etc., you may want to consider making arrangements to secure a home device for the 21-22 school year





PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **headphones to use in the Computer Lab.** Your child's headphones will be labeled with his/her name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Computer Lab. The headphones are used through 2nd grade at Monsignor Slade. Students in grades 3 -8 may continue to use the purchased headphones or may use ear buds purchased on their own. Also, due to Health Department regulations, each child must have his/her own **safety goggles to use in the Science Lab.** Safety goggles will be labeled with the student's name and kept in a plastic, ziploc bag in the Science Lab. Goggles are supplied in the 6th grade and are used throughout the student's middle school years at Slade.

** Included in the cost of the packet for grades 4-8, there is a novel fee for required reading. The cost of these novel fees are as follows: Grade 4 - \$9.00, Grade 5 - \$10.00, Grade 6 - \$16.00, Grade 7 - \$20.00, Grade 8 - \$17.00. This money is collected at the time your packet is purchased; however, the novels will be distributed by your student's teacher.

Included in the required packet for grades 6, 7 & 8 is a \$6.00 **Science Lab fee** used to offset supplies used in the Science Lab.
