Important News and Notes:

- **Parent Survey Results** Several weeks ago, a six-question survey was sent to all families; thank you to all who were able to respond as you provided invaluable information regarding some of our programming. After reviewing your responses and consulting with our teachers and staff, we have been able to make some informed decisions:
 - We will continue to prepackage our school supplies that are sold at the beginning of each year as a convenience to our parents.
 - The principal's update will continue to be emailed each Friday in an effort to keep open, on-going communication.
 - The activity points program has been discontinued. We found that as it evolved over time it no longer aligned with the philosophy of the school and the mission of Catholic service.
 - We will be formulating a committee to investigate the potential for changing uniform companies.
 - We will be formulating a committee to investigate the potential for changing our lunch program.
 - ♦ We will continue with the Science Explorers after-school enrichment program.



Dear Parents, Students, Teachers, and Staff,

Tommy's Food Service will be serving our first lunch in the cafeteria on Tuesday, August 30, 2016. Attached is the menu for August & September 2016 and Tommy's Lunch 101. The cafeteria will be using a complete oven baking system whereby no foods will be fried.

We will again be instituting a Lunch Account Debit System in the cafeteria this year whereby each student and staff member will have their own account number for purchases. And will be issuing lunch account numbers to new students prior to the first lunch day on August 30st. If you were here previously you will use same account number. The amount you put on the Debit System will be at your own discretion depending on your anticipated purchases. We accept checks payable to Tommy, cash in an envelope with your child's name or lunch account number for proper credit, or online payment via PayPal. PayPal instructions are available online at www.Tommysfoodservice.com. There will be NO CASH sales at the cashier register. We would greatly appreciate that all accounts remain current, as this is a Debit Account System and not a Charge Account. Lunch account history and account balance can be viewed at www.mymealmoney.com. All purchases remain on the system for 30 days.

The combo lunch is \$4.00 it includes the entrée, choice of milk or juice. The following items can be purchase separately: milk, fruit juices, water, fruits, homemade soup, assorted subs (e.g. turkey or ham & cheese), assorted salads (e.g. tuna, chicken or egg), cookies, potato chips, ice cream, yogurt and other snacks. Available daily except pizza day: hotdogs and grilled cheese sandwiches for \$2.50 or combo for \$4.00. Papa John's Pizza will be served on PIZZA DAY it includes a slice of pizza and milk for \$2.75 or just a slice for \$2.00. Prices remain the same from last year.

TOMMY'S LUNCH 101

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Tommy's Food Service is truly blessed and thankful to be a part of the Monsignor Slade community. We strive to provide a variety of your child's favorite foods and healthy snacks, as well as a pleasant experience for you. We do not fry any foods, and prepare most items from scratch each morning using the highest quality products available. Many of our recipes have been in the family for years.

School Lunch Accounts 101

It is very important to remember that lunch accounts utilize a debit system – there is no credit. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to fund the account, monitor purchases online, and discuss purchasing habits with their child.

We ask that you maintain a positive balance of \$20.00 in the account. The price for a hot lunch of the day is \$4.00 and includes an entrée, side, and vegetable. The average student spends around \$25/week when purchasing daily lunch, and occasional snacks.

Funding the Lunch Account

There are several ways to add money to your child's lunch account. We accept checks** and online payments via PayPal which we will notify you when this is instituted. Please make checks payable to **Tommy** and include the child's name or lunch account number on the memo line.

**There is a \$30 NSF fee assessed to the lunch account for each returned check, this covers our bank fees.

To send a payment via PayPal, visit <u>http://www.tommyfoodservice.com</u> and click on the PayPal button for each school. Always include your child's name or lunch account number for proper credit. Please note a fee of 2.9% + 30 cents will be deducted (by PayPal, not Tommy's) and the adjusted amount will be credited to your lunch account on the following business day.

Negative Account Policy*

Students will be told verbally when they reach a \$0.00 balance, and written notice when the account reaches (-\$5.00) and we only send email once a week (maybe Thursday). Students with negative accounts will only be given the lunch of the day (but no extras, e.g. cookies). Then if the account continues to be negative we will not serve lunch to the students, just a cheese sandwich. Currently, we do not charge any fees if the account falls negative.

Being told they have a zero or negative balance can be upsetting or embarrassing for some students, so please make sure they understand if there is no money in the account, they cannot purchase extras. We try to be flexible and gentle, always giving students a verbal warning when they are approaching the "No Snack Zone".

Monitoring Accounts Online

Go to the <u>www.mymealmoney.com</u> link for your school. Enter the last name, and ID # in the respective fields. Instead of pressing the enter key on your keyboard, you'll need to manually click on the green GO button. You will see an overview of your child's account in the yellow box immediately below. Parenthesis around the amount (\$0.00) indicates a negative balance. Once you see your child's name and homeroom information, then you can click on the History button to the left to view account details and 30 days of history. Current day history is available after 3:00pm. *The website is not supported on Internet Explorer 9 Beta.

Purchasing Habits

Please consider this a great opportunity to discuss healthy eating habits with your child and begin teaching them about basic money management. These life skills truly begin at home.

We understand that students don't always respect their parent's instructions. If your child does not have your permission to use a lunch account, you must notify Tommy's in writing and bring the account to a zero balance before it will be closed. Otherwise, accounts remain open and available for use.
