Important News and Notes:

General email address to report Student Absence: Parents, if you are emailing the school regarding a student absence, please use the following email address: absences@msladeschool.com. Reporting absences at the beginning of the school day will eliminate the need for the school nurse to contact you during the day.

Grandparents' Day Date Change: Due to a scheduling conflict, The Pre-K, K, and 1st grade Grandparents' Day will be changed from April 11th to April 16th, with doors opening at 8:30 a.m. The 2nd/3rd and 4th/5th Grandparents' Day will be changed from April 12th to April 17th, with doors opening at 8:30 a.m.

Family Income Survey: Yesterday, you should have received a paper copy of the yearly family income survey. Please fill out one survey for each child in your household that attends Slade and return it to the homeroom teacher no later than September 21st. The information that you provide is kept strictly confidential. As stated in the letter, your participation in this survey will benefit our school with E-rate funding for technology, State Textbook funding, and professional development for teachers and administration.

Parking Lot Safety: Because the safety of our students, parents, and staff is always foremost, we would like to take the opportunity to remind you of traffic procedures in place to make our arrival and dismissal as safe and efficient as possible.

1. Please become thoroughly familiar with the drop-off and pick-up procedures on pp. 42-45 of our Parent & Student Handbook.
2. Please cross between the yellow cones when walking students from the parking lot to the building during morning drop-off.
3. Please encourage children to exit your vehicle on the right so that they are not walking into an active traffic lane.
4. Please do not park in the Edu-Care Lot or the Faculty Parking Lot in order to drop off or pick up students.
5. Please follow the directions of any staff member or safety patrol member on the parking lot.
6. Please adhere to the one-way traffic sign posted on the roadway outside of the cafeteria. U-turns are not permitted on this roadway.

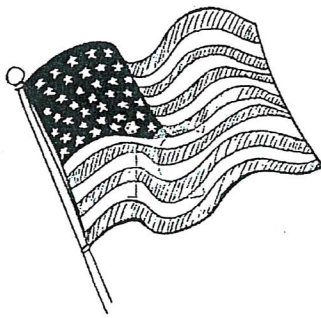

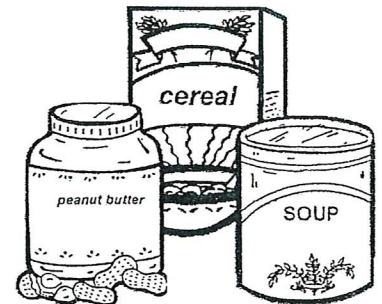

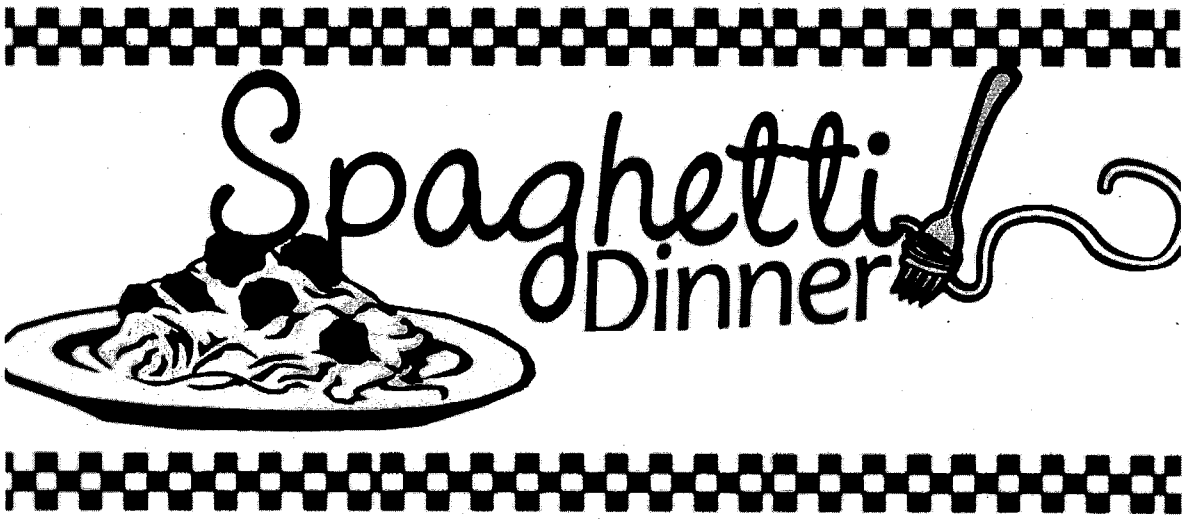
