Important News & Notes:

In Memoriam - Kathy Shatt: Please remember Kathleen (Kathy) Anne Shatt, MSCS School Board member and mother of two Slade alumni, James and Brian, who passed away on Monday, September 7, 2020. Family Income Survey: Each year, the Maryland State Department of Education tasks the Archdiocese of Baltimore schools with collecting family income data. Historically, families have received a paper that is filled out and returned to school. This year, the information will be collected through a secure Google form: <u>https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSfgzg7It0zs4nQXaAiWsZf9fMw0wOlm8d4ISVkHZrW0CQ2_yQ/viewform</u>. The information gathered through this survey is completely confidential and will assist Monsignor Slade Catholic School in receiving state textbook funding and grants. Families are asked to **complete one survey per student** enrolled in Pre-K-8th grades at Monsignor Slade. The survey takes approximately 2-4 minutes to do and they must be completed by October 15, 2020. We appreciate your prompt attention to this very important matter.

Arrival/Dismissal: Each day, we are finding that drop-off and pick-up are improving. Much of the thanks goes to you, our parents, who are so willing to adapt to the procedures and follow the many directions of our staff members. Just a few reminders:

Morning Arrival - Please display a sign with the last name(s) of the child(ren) you are dropping off. If you have a Pre-K4 child in your car, please indicate that grade level on your sign as well. Follow the blue lines which will take you to a lane where your children can exit the car. Please wait for a staff member to check that you have completed the Wellness Survey, at which time students can exit the vehicle.

Afternoon Pick-up - Please park in any row facing the playground, except for the row closest to it. That last row is reserved for late cars entering the lot. Please wait for a staff member to dismiss you before moving your vehicle.

Given the timeliness of family arrivals, we are able to adjust our late entry times for students; we do not need as much leeway as originally anticipated with the staggered drop off. Therefore, beginning on Monday, September 14, late times will be adjusted to the following:

Grade 6-8 students who enter the building after 7:55 a.m. or later are considered late. Grade 3-5 students who enter the building after 8:05 a.m. or later are considered late. Grade 1-2 students who enter the building after 8:10 a.m. or later are considered late. Pre-K4 students who enter the building after 8:15 a.m. are considered late.
