Important News & Notes:

Family Income Data Survey: Collecting family income data is a requirement of MSDE, and we must do so annually. The Archdiocese of Baltimore will again be using a Google form survey to collect family income data for the 2022-2023 school year.

This safe and secure electronic income survey will automatically collect a family's data as they complete it. The information garnered is instrumental for the school to obtain grant monies and State textbook funding. The AOB has worked in conjunction with each county in the development of the survey, and it meets each county's reporting requirements.

Parking Lot reminders:

Once the bell rings at 7:55 a.m., faculty, staff members, and safeties must make their way into the building to begin their days. If arriving at school after this time, parents are asked to pull into a parking space and walk their children up to the carport entrance. This policy is for the safety of all students.

For those families with children in grades Pre-K4 - 1 who are using the concierge line when arriving at school, please make sure your signs are posted in the drivers side front window and, if needed, please tilt them up so that faculty members can see it.

Please be reminded, if you are arriving at school by using the armory entrance, your children are not to exit the car while in the driveway; nor should they be crossing through the lawn next to the driveway unescorted. They need to wait until you are safely in a drop-off lane where there are faculty members and safeties to assist your children.

Important News and Notes (continued):

In order to avoid the back up in the morning at the entrance near the parish center, parents have been taking a 'shortcut' through the Pascal Senior Center parking lot. Please do not do this as it further clogs the driveway entrance and also creates an additional safety hazard for patrons of the senior center. We have been asked by the Pascal Center to advise our parents that this 'shortcut' is not permitted.

If parents of students in grades 1-5 have the ability to delay their arrival time in the morning, please do so in order to alleviate some of the congestion. Please remember that middle school students must be in the building no later than 7:43 a.m. Grades K-5 need to report in by 8:00 a.m and Pre-K4 by 8:15 a.m.

Finally, please remember that all students must be picked up from the parking lot. Families may not park across the street or at the armory. Only families picking up children inside the cafeteria from Extended Care may park outside the cafeteria during the dismissal process.

Thank you in advance for your continued support and cooperation as we try to focus on safety and efficiency during drop-off and pick-up.





Dear Parent,

I am writing this letter to offer your child an opportunity to participate in a research study at the Kennedy Krieger Institute. The study is looking at brain differences and learning differences in children. We are looking for children ages 6 through 17 who are typical learners, as well as children with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), High-Functioning Autism (ASD), or Tourette Syndrome (TS).

This content is neither sponsored nor endorsed by Monsignor Slade Catholic School. Monsignor Slade Catholic School has not shared any of your personal information with us but have allowed us to distribute this information through your child's teacher.

Our research studies take place over two-three days. The testing is done at the Kennedy Krieger Institute in Baltimore. On the morning of the first day, children will receive an IQ test and other academic achievement testing. Children will have a one-hour break for lunch with their parents, along with several shorter breaks throughout the day. For some studies, children will also complete a practice MRI scan to get them accustomed to lying still in the MRI scanner and the noises that the machine makes.

On the second day, participants will complete any remaining testing and may complete a real MRI scan. No radiation or dyes are used, only magnets. Children again have a one-hour break for lunch, before coming back for computer-game tests which look at learning, attention, and memory.

For their participation, children will receive a check in the amount they earned. Typically, participants receive \$50.00 per day. If they completed an MRI scan, they will also receive a picture of their brain. You will also receive a report on the IQ and achievement test results of your child. There is no charge to participate in the study.
