- **PowerSchool Update – Parent Access** is still closed to our families. The Archdiocese and PowerSchool Group, LLC, are continuing to explore solutions to the problems. 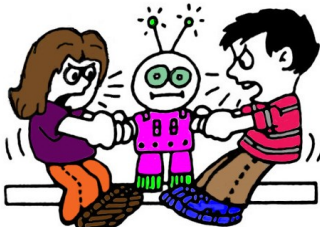

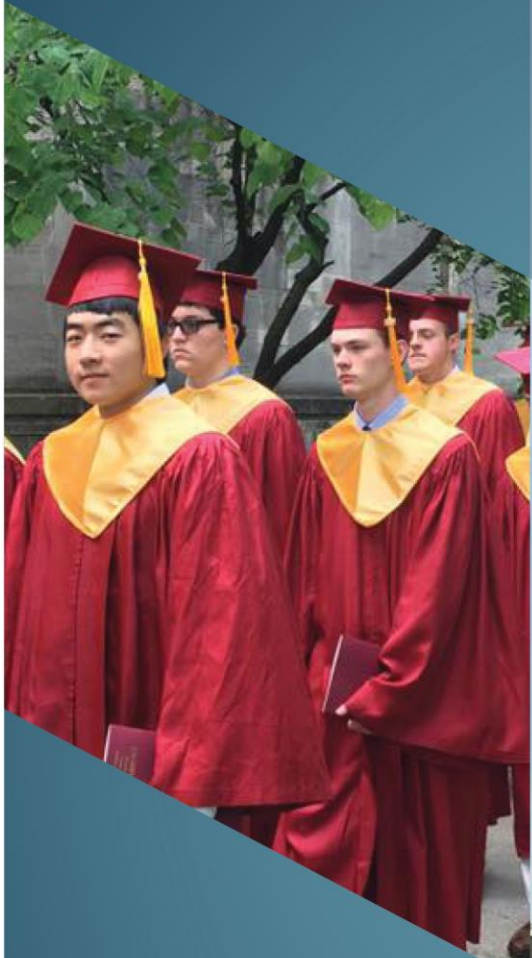

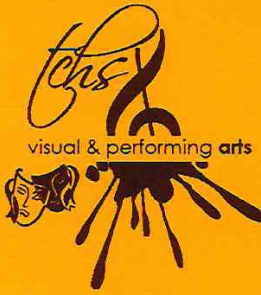
