Important News and Notes:

HASA General Meeting Guest Speaker and Date Change: Our Home and School Association meeting scheduled for Wednesday, October 9, will be moved to Tuesday, October 8, at 6:30 p.m. Corporal James Shiloh from the Anne Arundel County Police Department will be presenting an Active Assailant Training program for parents. The faculty and staff of MSCS were fortunate to receive this same training prior to the start of school. We encourage one parent from each family to attend this important informational evening. This is a parent night only; please do not bring children. Each family represented will receive a ticket to win a \$50 Visa gift card. The winner will be drawn the same evening and must be present to win. Forms due to the Office: Over the past several weeks, blue Emergency Forms have been handed out to all families. The school must have a blue Emergency Form on file for each Slade student in your family. There are still many forms outstanding. Please be sure to complete, sign and return the form(s) to the office as soon as possible. Also, if you have not done so, please return the Service Hours Program Sign-up Form for your family. In addition, please make sure the following documents are completed and uploaded through your parent portal: The MSDE Health Inventory, Maryland Immunization Form, and for kindergarten students, the Parent Observation Form. We ask you to please attend to these important matters at your very earliest convenience. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

Parking Lot Safety: Because the safety of our students, parents, and staff is always foremost, we would like to take the opportunity to remind you of traffic procedures in place to make our arrival and dismissal as safe and efficient as possible.

1. Please become thoroughly familiar with the drop-off and pick-up procedures on pp. 42-45 of our Parent & Student Handbook.
2. Please cross between the yellow cones when walking students from the parking lot to the building during morning drop-off.
3. Please encourage children to exit your vehicle so that they are not walking into an active traffic lane.
4. Please do not park in the Edu-Care Lot or the Faculty Parking Lot in order to drop off or pick up students.
5. Please follow the directions of any staff member or safety patrol member on the parking lot.
6. Please adhere to the one-way traffic sign posted on the roadway outside of the cafeteria. U-turns are not permitted on this roadway.
7. Incoming traffic for afternoon pick-up will be stopped at 2:43 p.m. so that no cars are moving through the parking lot when children are dismissed.

“Spirit of Slade”

Referral Program

Monsignor Slade Catholic School sponsors a family referral program, “Spirit of Slade,” which rewards the families of currently enrolled Pre-K4—7th grade families who refer new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School.



- ◆ Open to all MSCS families with students currently enrolled in Pre-K4 through 7th grade
- ◆ For every new family that lists your family's name in the “Referred by” field on their enrollment application and completes one full year of school at MSCS, your family will receive a **\$500** tuition credit for the following school year.
- ◆ Tuition credits are awarded on a per family, not per student, basis.
- ◆ You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total tuition rate for one student in a family in any given year. Credits will not be applied until a family’s FACTS account is activated for the year in which the credits are to be received. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.

To help as you refer new families:

- ◆ A new family is defined as a family not currently enrolled in Pre-K4 through 8th grades at MSCS.
- ◆ Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.

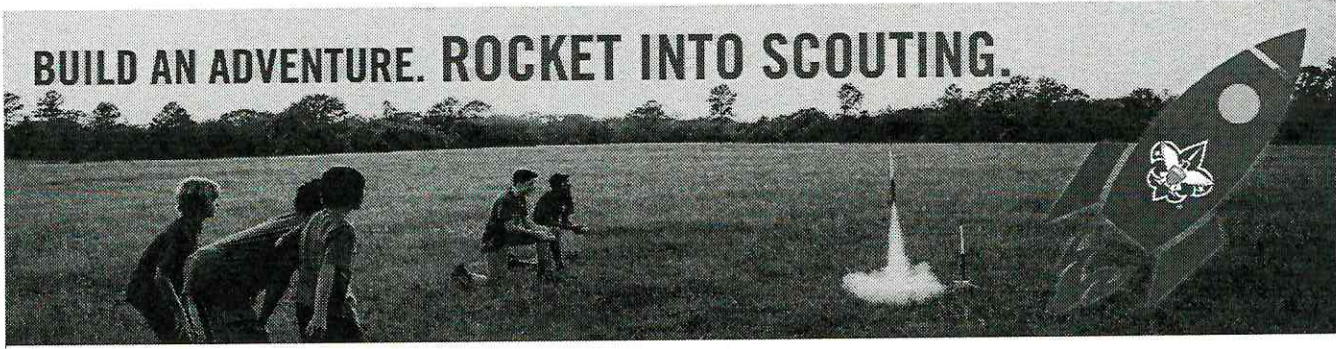
