Important News & Notes:

Staffing Update: Last week, Mrs. Cox talked about our new teachers for the 2021-2022 school year, as well as some staffing changes with existing faculty. There were a few other changes and/or additions we neglected to mention. First, we are happy to announce that Mrs. Lisa Benitez has returned to Monsignor Slade and will resume her role as a 4th grade teacher. In addition, Mrs. Natalie McFarlane will now serve as a kindergarten teacher and Ms. Michele Cameron will serve as a Pre-K4 teacher. We congratulate these teachers and wish them well in their new roles.

Parents of Pre-K4 and K students may park and walk their children to their classrooms on their first day of school. Parents should park along the back fence or in the parking row closest to the playground. All adults must be masked to enter the building.

- Acknowledgement Agreement Regarding COVID 19
- COVID-19 School Assumption of Risk Statement
- O Waiver, Release, and Indemnification Agreement Regarding Mask Use

Log onto your SchoolAdmin portal to complete any remaining forms that must be on file for the 2021 - 2022 academic year at <u>msladeschool.schooladminonline.com/portal</u>.

Family Income Data Survey: Collecting family income data is a requirement of MSDE, and we must do so annually. The Archdiocese of Baltimore will again be using a Google form survey to collect family income data for the 21-22 school year.

This safe and secure electronic income survey will automatically collect a family's data as they complete it. The information garnered is instrumental for the school to obtain grant monies and State textbook funding. The AOB has worked in conjunction with each county in the development of the survey, and it meets each county's reporting requirements.

Please complete one survey per student. Each one, due by October 1, 2021, takes approximately 2-4 minutes. The link to our survey is https://forms.gle/Tt3SMfKbPGRrUuni7. We appreciate your attention to this very important matter!

Class Lists: In the event that your family was unable to attend our annual Ice Cream Social where students find out who their homeroom teachers are, we have attached the class lists to this update for your convenience.

Updated Mask Information: We are amending our handbook policy regarding the types of masks that may be worn. Students may opt to wear disposable masks, such as the N95 mask, now that they are no longer in short supply for front-line workers. If a disposable mask is worn, it must be in a solid Slade uniform color of white, black, red, hunter green, or yellow.

Instrumental Music Program: The Monsignor Slade Catholic School band program is alive and well for the 2021-2022 school year! We have received detailed information from the Instrumental Music Program, who implements our band program and weekly lessons for students, that they will perform a band demonstration for students in grades 4-8 on Wednesday, September 15, 2021. At that time, any students who are interested in participating in band will be asked to fill out an interest form. Then, Mr. Wes Osment, our band director, will be in contact with parents of interested students to further discuss the program.

From the School Nurse:

Health Forms

Upon entering Monsignor Slade Catholic School, students must have a complete physical and required immunizations. The physical must be completed within nine months prior to enrolling in school for the first time, or within six months after starting school for the first time. The Health Inventory form, which you will need to take with you to your child's physical, can be found in your School Admin portal.

Parents are also required to complete an MSDE Emergency Form, which will be included with your child's school supply packets. This form provides the Health Room with necessary information, including allergies, serious medical conditions, medications, and emergency contact information. Please ensure that the back of the form is completed and signed. The school must be notified of any changes that occur during the year.

Required Immunizations

For the 2021-2022 school year, there are new immunization requirements for children.

- All students entering kindergarten through grade 7 must have had TWO varicella vaccinations.
- All students entering grades 7-12 must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.

These new requirements are in addition to the existing school immunization requirements.

Existing requirements:

• Kindergarten, Grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:

- ♦ DTaP/DTP/DT/Td 3 doses
- ♦ Polio 3 doses
- ♦ Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 doses
- ♦ Varicella 2 doses
- ♦ Hepatitis B 3 doses

Grade 7 & 8 ONLY:

- ♦ Tdap 1 dose
- ♦ Meningococcal 1 dose

From the School Nurse (continued):

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the *Maryland Recommend-ed Childhood Immunization Schedule*. A child has up to 20 days from the start of school to show proof of vaccinations or that they have started a plan to get the missing immunizations.

Medications At School

If a student's physician recommends that the student receive prescription or over-the-counter medication during the school day, a medication form signed by the student's licensed health care provider is required. Forms are available on the Monsignor Slade Catholic School website and can be found under the Forms & Documents section of the Parents tab. (Link to forms: https://www.msladeschool.com/resources/forms-documents) Medication, both prescription and non-prescription, can only be dispensed with this medication form, signed by the health care provider and parent, specifying start and stop dates.

ALL medications must be delivered to the school by the parent/guardian in their original boxes or containers. Medications delivered to the school nurse by the student will not be accepted for use, but will be placed in a locked cabinet until the parent/guardian picks up the medication or signs for it.
