New COVID-19 Guidelines

Updated CDC/MDH guidance for individuals experiencing respiratory viruses, including COVID-19, is as follows:

- ◊ If an individual tests **positive** for COVID **with symptoms**, isolation is required until the individual is fever free without the use of medication for a period of 24 hours prior to returning to school.
- ◊ If an individual tests **positive** for COVID **with no symptoms**, no isolation is required until and unless the individual develops related symptoms. If that should occur, then the individual must follow the isolation guidelines for those testing positive for COVID-19 with symptoms.

When an individual returns to normal activities, additional precautions over the next 5 days are *recommended*, such as taking additional steps for cleaner air, hygiene, masks, physical distancing, and/or testing when you will be around other people indoors. This is especially important to protect people with factors that increase their risk of severe illness from respiratory viruses.

Recruitment and Enrollment:

Enrollment

Waitlists have formed in PreK-2 (full-day), PreK-3 (full-day), PreK-4, Kindergarten, and 2nd Grades. We anticipate waitlists forming in 3rd, 4th, and 6th Grades, too.

Completing '24-'25 Enrollment: Enrollment agreements for the 2024-2025 academic year were sent on March 1, 2024. All enrollment agreements must be completed and FACTS accounts activated by April 1, 2024. Current students for whom re-enrollment is incomplete on April 2, 2024 will be assessed a late processing fee of \$100 per student. These fees will be applied to the associated FACTS account for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Financial Assistance: The State of Maryland has opened BOOST applications for the 2024-2025 school year; this scholarship is offered to FARMs-eligible students. 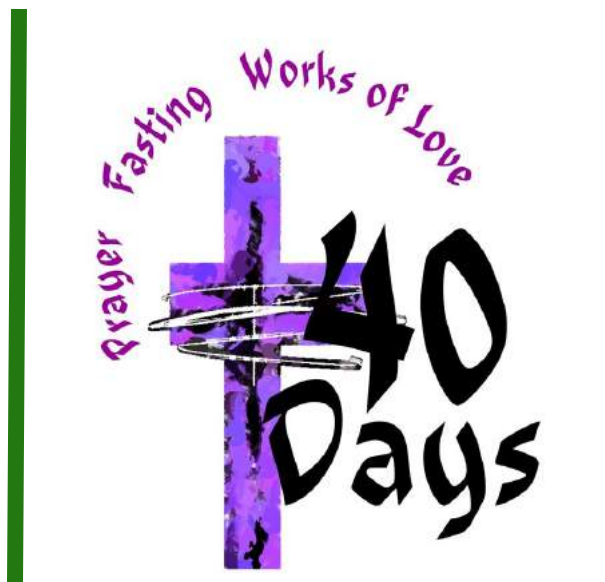

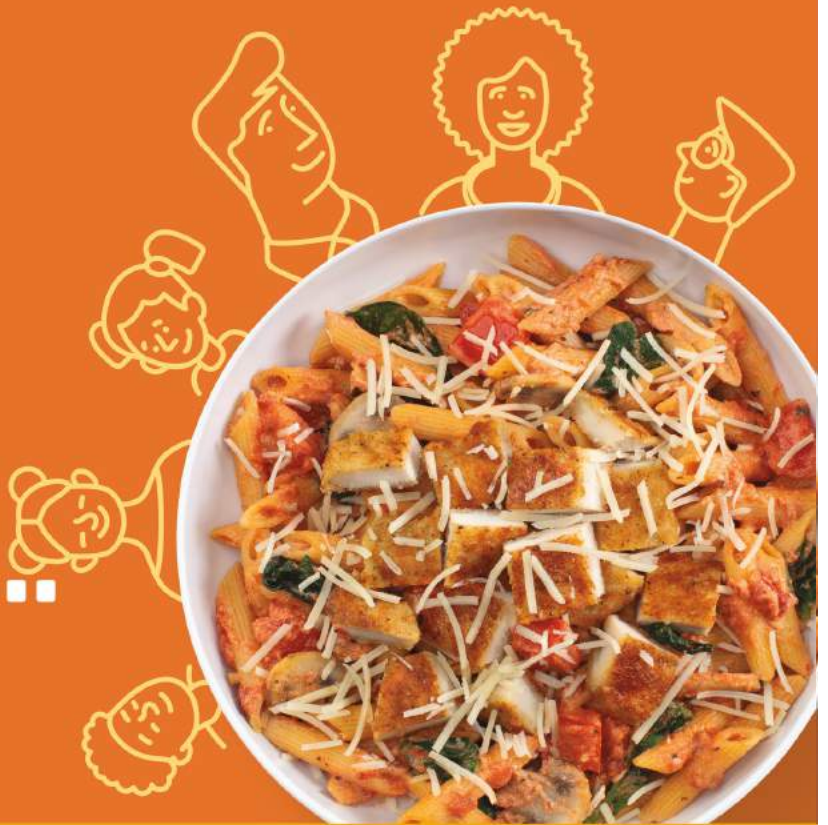
