Important News & Notes:

Fall Open House - November 10th: Thanks to the hard work of the advancement director, our admissions director and the hospitality committee, our November open house held today was a tremendous success! We had approximately 60 families attend and many were interested in applying after touring today and seeing all the wonderful things happening in the classrooms. Thank you to all the teachers, staff, and students who were so welcoming to the families. Many positive comments were made about the students being engaged in their lessons and doing such fun activities in the classroom. In addition, our student ambassadors did a fabulous job presenting our school and speaking about all the good things that go on here every day!

"Keep Christ in Christmas" Poster Contest: Students in grades K-8 have the opportunity to participate in the 'Keep Christ in Christmas' poster contest, which is sponsored by the Father McGivney Council of the Knights of Columbus. There are three age divisions: Grades K-2, 3-5, and 6-8. All entries must be submitted on 12" X 18" paper. Apopka Toy Drive: In partnership with the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur, Monsignor Slade has participated in the Apopka Toy Drive for over 35 years! The toys that



are donated from our school fill "The Christmas Store" in Apopka, Florida, and support the low-income farmworkers in that area. Since the farmworkers are a proud community, this store allows them to buy Christmas gifts for their children at a reduced rate, rather than having to accept charity. If you would like to make a donation, please purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good-quality arts & crafts kits, educational games and books, skateboards, scooters, dolls of all colors, cars and

trucks, sports balls of all kinds, etc., and send them into school as soon as possible. The "store" can also use diapers, baby toys, clothing and blankets for infants and toddlers, as well as new socks, pajamas and underwear for boys and girls. The toy drive ends on December 4th. We hope that your family will be able to contribute to this worthwhile service project.

Dear 8th Grade Parents.

As you are aware, Wednesday, November 29, 2023, all 8th grade students who have paid the registration fee will be taking the official HSPT here at Slade. As with any standardized testing, it is important that students get a good night's rest beforehand and have a healthy breakfast/snack before coming to school.

It is imperative that students are prompt in their morning arrival on the 29th. The exam will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at approximately 11:00 a.m. If students are late, they will not be admitted to the testing room until there is a break between subtests. Any missed subtests will need to be made up immediately following the last subtest. Because this will impact students' lunch time, we ask that you make every effort to have your student at school on time.

There are short breaks built into the exam for a snack and restroom use. All students should bring a bottle of water and a snack for those breaks. Additionally, students should bring several #2 pencils.

Once the test is complete, students will return to homerooms to debrief with their teachers. We recognize that, as this is the first major exam that our 8th graders experience, the students will be exhausted. Therefore, there will be no classes for the remainder of that day. 8th grade students will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m.

Supervision past 11:30 a.m. will not be offered as teachers have other grade-level classes to teach for the remainder of the day. Therefore, students who utilize extended care will need to be picked up by 11:30 a.m. A reminder that students are not required to take the HSPT if they are not applying to a Catholic high school. Therefore, students who will not be taking the test may stay home from school with an excused absence on Wednesday, November 29th.

Referral Program

Monsignor Slade Catholic School sponsors a family referral program, "Spirit of Slade," which rewards the families of currently enrolled full-day Pre-K—7th grade families who refer new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School.



- Open to all MSCS families with students currently enrolled in full day Pre-K2 through 7th grade
- For every new family that lists your family's name in the "Referred by" field on their enrollment application and completes one full year of school at MSCS, your family will receive a **\$500** tuition credit for the following school year.
- Tuition credits are awarded on a per *FAMILY*, not per student, basis.
- You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total tuition rate for one student in a family in any given year. Credits will not be applied until a family's FACTS account is activated for the year in which the credits are to be received. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.



To help as you refer new families:

- A new family is defined as a family NOT currently enrolled in the Edu-Care program/Pre-K2-8th grades at MSCS.
- Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.
