#### **Recruitment & Enrollment**

- **Open House:** On November 10, 2023, Monsignor Slade will host a Prospective Parent Open from 8:30 a.m.-10:30 a.m.. Please spread the word on neighborhood websites, with parent groups, on social media, or with friends & relatives using the flyer provided.
- Enrollment for New Students Only: Preschool enrollment projections for next school year indicate a very limited number of openings in Pre-K2, Pre-K3, and Pre-K4. If you wish to submit an application for a student entering our Pre-K or any other grade at Monsignor Slade in 2024-2025, please do so ASAP. Applications opened for next year on October 2, 2023. While the sibling relationship is considered during application review, we cannot guarantee enrollment for all sibling applicants due to the limited number of seats in each class. This enrollment effort is not to be confused with re-registration for current students. The re-registration process will begin in late November. Please do not apply for students who are currently enrolled.
- **2024-2025 Re-registration:** Information regarding the re-registration process and instructions on how to re-register your current Slade student(s) will be sent via e-blast in early November.
- **Spirit of Slade Referral Program:** If all current students re-register in November, limited seats will be available for the 2024-2025 school year. Now is the time to refer a friend or family member! Monsignor Slade families can earn a \$500 referral credit toward their 2025-2026 tuition, after a referred, new student has been enrolled for a full year. Referred applicants must indicate the referring family name or student's name on the application. Referral credits cannot exceed full tuition expenses. See the attached flyer for more information.

## HASA General Meeting - Wednesday, November 8, 2023 - Guest Speaker

Please join us on Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. for the Home and School Association (HASA) General Meeting. Our guest speaker for the meeting will be Marco Johnson, who is a volunteer with the Red Cross Disaster preparedness team. He has served with the American Red Cross in several roles for over 10 years. These roles include National Capital & Greater Chesapeake Region Preparedness Lead delivering Community Preparedness Education, Be Red Cross Ready Activities, Hands-Only CPR Demonstrator, and instructor for the suite of Disaster Cycle Services courses. He received the Citizen of the Year Award in 2023 from the Fairfax County Federation of Citizens Associations, established in 1940.

The topic for the evening is Emergency Preparedness: Before, During, After. Emergencies can happen anytime, anywhere. Prepare before, during, and after for common emergencies and natural disasters to include preparing for self, others, pets, and different locations. Disasters, pandemics, lightning strikes, home fires, and windstorms occur anywhere. Get tips for preparedness steps to take today, what to do in an emergency, and how to repair and rebuild afterward.

Dear Parents and Students,

We are excited to tell you about a special tradition we have here at Monsignor Slade Catholic School during Christmastime. Once again, we will participate in sending toys to Apopka, Florida, for "The Christmas Store." This service project has been supported enthusiastically by students, parents and teachers alike for close to 40 years! This year, our Apopka Service Project will begin on Wednesday, November 1st, and conclude on Monday, December 4th.

Apopka is a migrant farm-worker community located just outside Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The farm-workers of Apopka work hard picking crops but are only paid a minimum wage, and struggle to raise their families and provide for daily needs. In an effort to help the workers, the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur developed, "The Christmas Store," a place where donated, new toys are sold for a nominal price. Since the farm-workers are very proud and prefer to buy toys for their children rather than receive charity, they can freely select a gift for their child like we do, and can leave the shop with dignity. All proceeds are turned back to the community to fund educational programs, such as literacy and pesticide training.

If you would like to participate, purchase one or more new toys with your child, such as good arts & crafts kits, "pretend" jewelry and make-up kits, educational games and books, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, tricycles, helmets, dolls of all colors, cars and trucks (especially medium/large vehicles), board games, and sports balls of all kinds. They can also use diapers, toys, clothing and blankets for infants and toddlers as well as new socks, pajamas and underwear for boys and girls. Allowing your child to help select the toy, and if possible, pay for part of it, will make the project more meaningful to your child.

We are very fortunate to have a great relationship with Southwest Airlines, who has generously agreed each year to provide air transport to Florida. Our student council members will pack up the toys on Tuesday, December 5th, and Southwest will come to pick up and then transport the toys to Apopka, Florida, on Wednesday, December 6th.

Our efforts in Apopka are greatly appreciated and are truly making a difference in the community. Thank you for your help and support!

# **Referral Program**

Monsignor Slade Catholic School sponsors a family referral program, "Spirit of Slade," which rewards the families of currently enrolled full-day Pre-K—7th grade families who refer new families to Monsignor Slade Catholic School.

- Open to all MSCS families with students currently enrolled in fullday Pre-K2 through 7th grade
- For every new family that lists your family's name in the "Referred by" field on their enrollment application and completes one full year of school at MSCS, your family will receive a **\$500** tuition credit for the following school year.
- Tuition credits are awarded on a per *FAMILY*, not per student, basis.
- You may refer more than one new family and receive additional credit. The amount of referral tuition credits cannot exceed the total tuition rate for one student in a family in any given year. Credits will not be applied until a family's FACTS account is activated for the year in which the credits are to be received. Tuition credits cannot be redeemed for cash.

# To help as you refer new families:

- A new family is defined as a family NOT currently enrolled in the Edu-Care program/Pre-K2-8th grades at MSCS.
- Prospective families must list the full name of a referring parent or student on their initial enrollment application. Only one family may be listed as a referring family. There are no exceptions.
